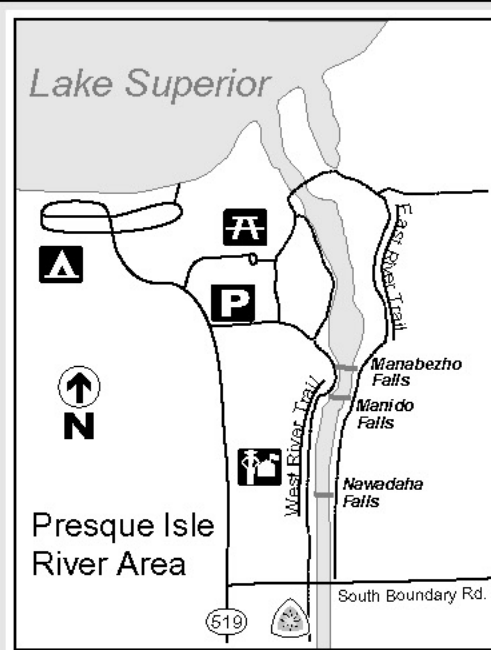
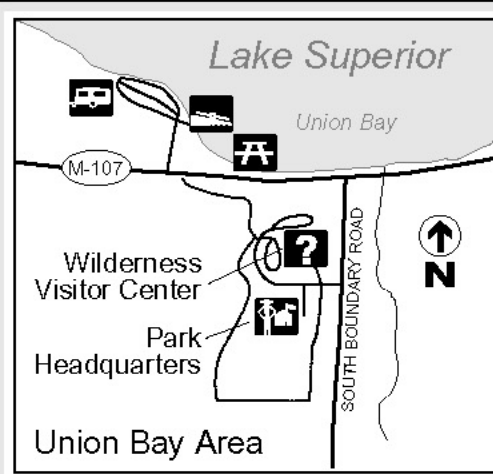


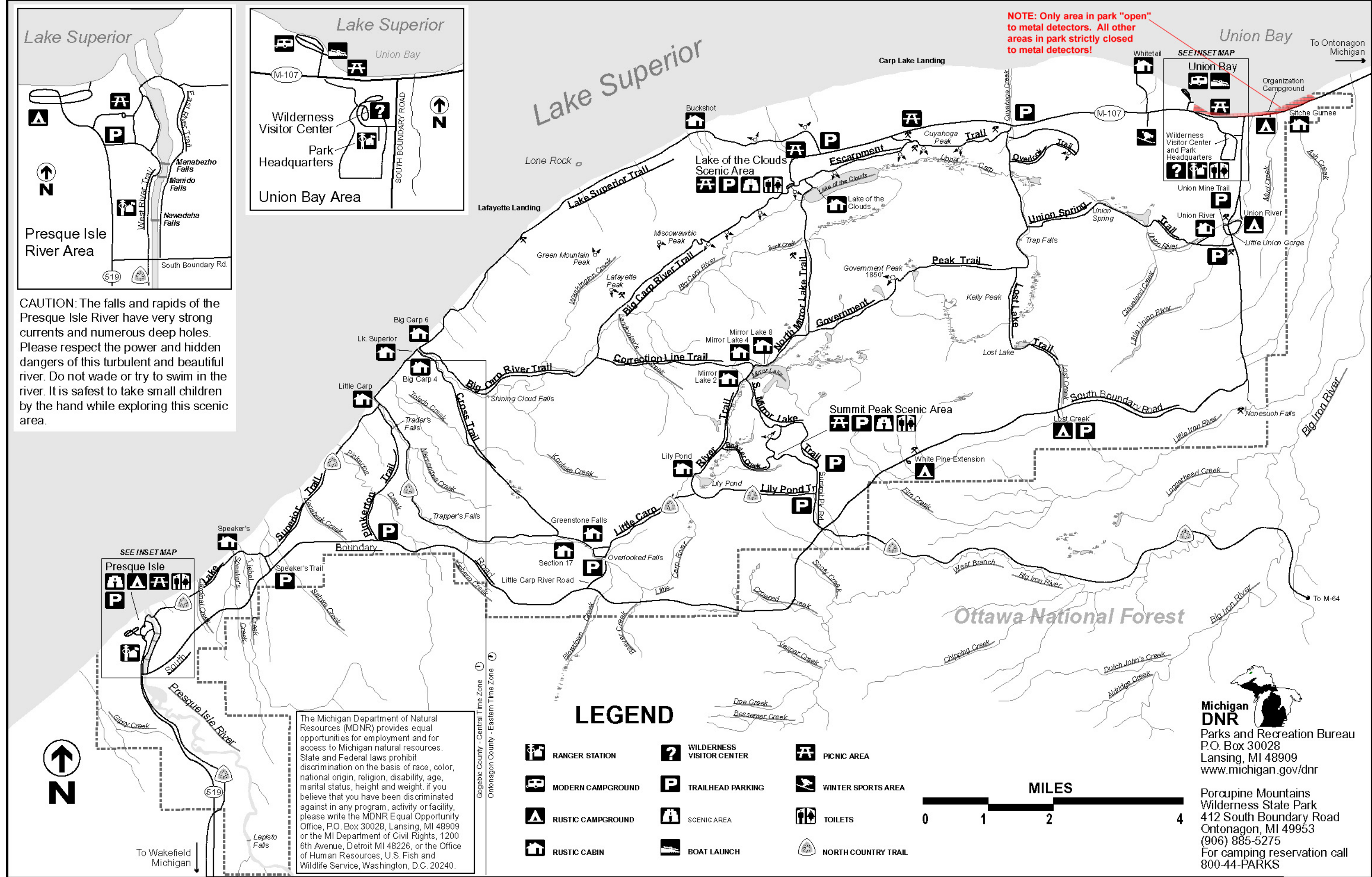
Porcupine Mountains Wilderness State Park



CAUTION: The falls and rapids of the Presque Isle River have very strong currents and numerous deep holes. Please respect the power and hidden dangers of this turbulent and beautiful river. Do not wade or try to swim in the river. It is safest to take small children by the hand while exploring this scenic area.



NOTE: Only area in park "open" to metal detectors. All other areas in park strictly closed to metal detectors!
