

## ***Kalamazoo River Hacklander***

### ***Fish Species***

Steelhead

### ***Species Description***

Brown trout catches are rare in this area, but steelhead may be caught during migration periods in the Kalamazoo River during winter and spring.

### ***Noteworthy***

Hacklander is located at the downstream section of the Pottawatomi Marsh and provides access to plenty of non fishing recreational opportunities through wetlands, river, and view of adjacent upland habitats within the Allegan State Game Area. Access for boats is a shallow graveled ramp. This location also has 44 parking spaces. There is a rustic toilet on site for public use.

### ***Fishing Regulations***

Kalamazoo River is not designated a trout stream through this section. Seasonal migrations of rainbow trout/steelhead can be caught through this area in winter and spring. Please refer to the Regulations for Streams Not Classified as Stream Type or Listed as a Gear Restricted Stream regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

### ***Directions to Site***

East of US Hwy 31, take Riverside Road/130th Avenue then turn north onto 63rd Avenue which leads to this DNR access site. This location provides for limited river access through a non-dredged and maintained wetland.
