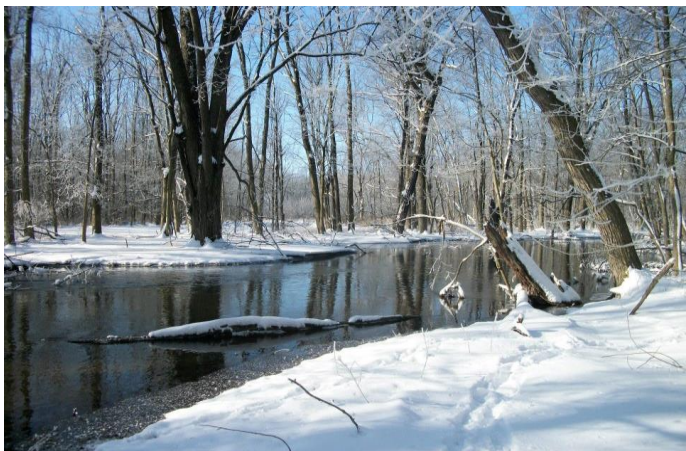

Brown trout are stocked in this area with sizes caught by anglers between 8 and 15 inches.

Noteworthy

This beautiful property used for public access is owned by the DNR and managed by the Calhoun Conservation District. It can be fished from the bank, by wading, or by kayak/canoe. There is ample parking at the entrance and Rice Creek can be seen toward the east. There is no boat launch and so a kayak or canoe must be carried in.

Fishing Regulations

Rice Creek is a designated Type 4 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

Driving north on Partello Road from I-94 and the City of Marshall, the entrance to this access site is less than one mile from I-94 and on the east side of the road.
