At this location Brook Trout may be found from 2 to 9 inches and Steelhead as adults as well as juveniles up to 10 inches.

Fishing Regulations

The area of the East Branch of Whitefish River at the CR-38 bridge crossing has split regulation types. Upstream from the bridge at CR-38 is designated as a Type 1 trout stream and downstream from the bridge at CR-38 is designated as a Type 4 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From the intersection of US-41 and County Road 38 travel east on CR-38 for approximately 7 miles to the second bridge crossing over the river. Access the river by using the county road right of way along the road and bridge. CR-38 is also sometimes referred to as Forest Service Road 2236.
