Species Description

Lake Michigan spawning runs of steelhead and Chinook salmon. Stocked brown and rainbow trout.

Noteworthy

Steelhead fishing occurs from late October through June and Chinook salmon during September and October. Brown trout and rainbow trout fishing occurs all year. Fishing is good by small boat and wading from the shoreline. Bait, lodging and food available in nearby Muskegon, Fremont and Newaygo.

Fishing Regulations

The Muskegon River in this area is designated a Type 4 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From the intersection of M-37 and M-82 (Croton Drive) on the north side of Newaygo, travel on Croton Drive east for 5 miles to the intersection of Pine Street from the south, then turn right and travel 1.1 miles to the access site entrance.
