### ***Fish Species***

Brook Trout; Brown Trout

### ***Species Description***

Both brook trout and brown trout may be found in this stretch of the Indian River. Brook trout are typically found up to 7 inches in length and brown trout are up to 8 inches in length.

### ***Noteworthy***

USFS Hiawatha National Forest Indian River Canoe Trail: The Indian River offers excellent canoeing and kayaking and provides beautiful and varied scenery, from canyon-like banks and sharp curves, to broad marshland reaches.

### ***Fishing Regulations***

The Indian River in this area is designated as a Type 1 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

### ***Directions to Site***

From the intersection of M-94 and County Road 449, travel south on CR-449 for approximately 1.4 miles. Turn right (west) on US Forest Service Road 2212 and proceed for approximately 0.3 miles. Continue to travel west (on foot) for approximately 0.1 miles.
