Brook Trout

Species Description

A good number of wild brook trout are present here. Anglers report catches of larger brook trout in this stream reach. Surveys typically find fish ranging in size from 7 to 12 inches but larger fish have been reported by anglers upwards of 17 inches.

Noteworthy

This stream can be a challenge to fish but those who do fish here have good results. Expect plenty of overhanging tag alder along the majority of the banks. Wading is the best approach for anglers. Most anglers will use natural bait on this type of stream hitting the deep holes in the bends and log jams.

Fishing Regulations

This section of the Little Two Hearted River is a designated Type 1 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

This site is located north of the village of Newberry. Drive north on M-123 for about 18 miles to County Road (CR) 500 and turn left. Follow CR 500 for about 7 miles to CR 501 (Fisher Bridge Road) and turn left (South). Once on CR 501, Fisher Bridge is just ahead crossing the Little Two Hearted River. Parking is limited to one vehicle alongside of the road. Access the stream directly from the bridge as private property is on both sides.
