Brook Trout

Species Description

Yearling brook trout are stocked annually. Anglers report good catches of brook trout with sizes ranging from 7 to 10 inches, not many bigger fish are reported.

Noteworthy

Wading is difficult making bank angling the primary approach here. Anglers who want to float with a canoe or kayak can access the creek off of the CR 405 bridge. Most anglers use natural bait and anglers who fish farther from the bridge tend to have better success.

Fishing Regulations

Teaspoon Creek at CR 405 is a designated Type 1 trout stream. Refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

This site is located west of the village of Newberry. Take Dollarville Road (County Road 405) west 3.3 miles to the bridge crossing on Teaspoon Creek. From M-28, go north on County Road (CR) 405 for 1.3 miles to the bridge crossing.
