Wild brook trout to 12 inches and wild brown trout to 20 inches are found here.

Noteworthy

Anglers of the Au Sable has done a considerable amount of habitat work in this reach which is funded in part by the DNR Fisheries Division Habitat Improvement Account. Habitat work includes placement of whole trees and log structures.

Fishing Regulations

The North Branch of the Au Sable River at the Powerline is a designated Gear Restricted stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From County Road 612, drive north on Twin Bridges Road for just under a mile until you reach a small "Fishing Access Site" sign which is directly beneath the power line. There is parking for 3 or 4 cars along the road. There is a path that leads to the river which is about 150 yards away from the parking area.
