### ***Fish Species***

Brown Trout; Rainbow Trout

### ***Species Description***

Some wild brown trout are present here and both rainbow trout and brown trout are stocked. Brown trout typically range from 7-18 inches, but some fish can approach 25 inches. Rainbow trout, typically age 1 fish, range from 7-10 inches, with occasional fish up to 16 inches caught.

### ***Noteworthy***

Wading water is limited, but available with caution. There are stairs down to the water. Good presentations to use are dry flies, nymphs, spinners and crankbaits. The river is approximately 150 feet wide and highly scenic. This is U.S. Forest Service property, federal laws apply.

### ***Directions to Site***

From the junction of M72/33 highway and County Road 600/F32; take F32 east approximately 2 miles to the overlook sign on the south side of road.
