IDENTIFICATION OF SPECIMENS PICKED UP IN MEAT MARKET, BARRY  
COUNTY AND SUBMITTED FOR IDENTIFICATION

The 13 inch fish (total length) is a sauger (Stizostedion canadense) and the 12 1/4 inch specimen (total length) is a blue pike (Stizostedion glaucum). The characters of the yellow pike or wall-eye (Stizostedion vitreum) and of the sauger are contrasted in Report No. 99. We shall prepare a similar identification chart covering the blue pike.
