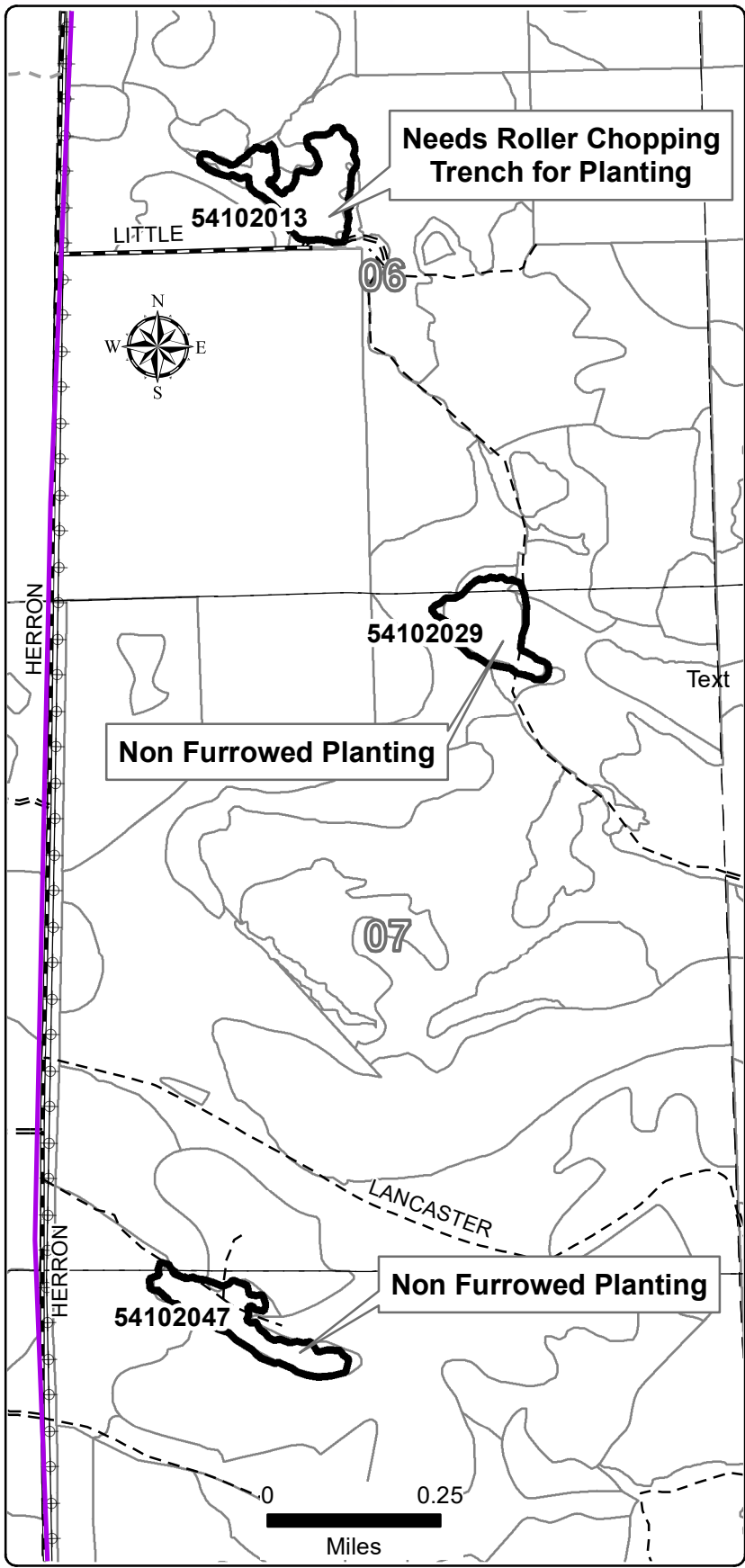

Unfurrowed planting is suggested.</p>
