

Slash Note:

A chipping exemption was granted on the harvest contract (due to poor chip markets) provided there was close utilization & the slash was spread out. Unit 2's pine residual broke down well and was spread out by grapple skidder. Unit 1's pine-oak type had more deciduous understory and it took the forwarder several days to distribute the slash. That unit may still need to be roller chopped due to the oak slash load.

Covertype Objective: PLANTED RP Acres: **69**

Approved Methods:

Trench & plant RP. Site prep & release treatments may include chopping, herbicide & pre-commercial thinning.

Comments:

Buried pipelines follow most of the roads surrounding the planting blocks. There is a pair of surface pipelines along 7 Mile Rd. A fibercast pipeline corridor separates Units 1 & 2. Saplings &/or tall stumps were left overtop all pipeline corridors. H2S Gas field. Buried pipelines can only be crossed at armored crossings (see gravel caps on map).
