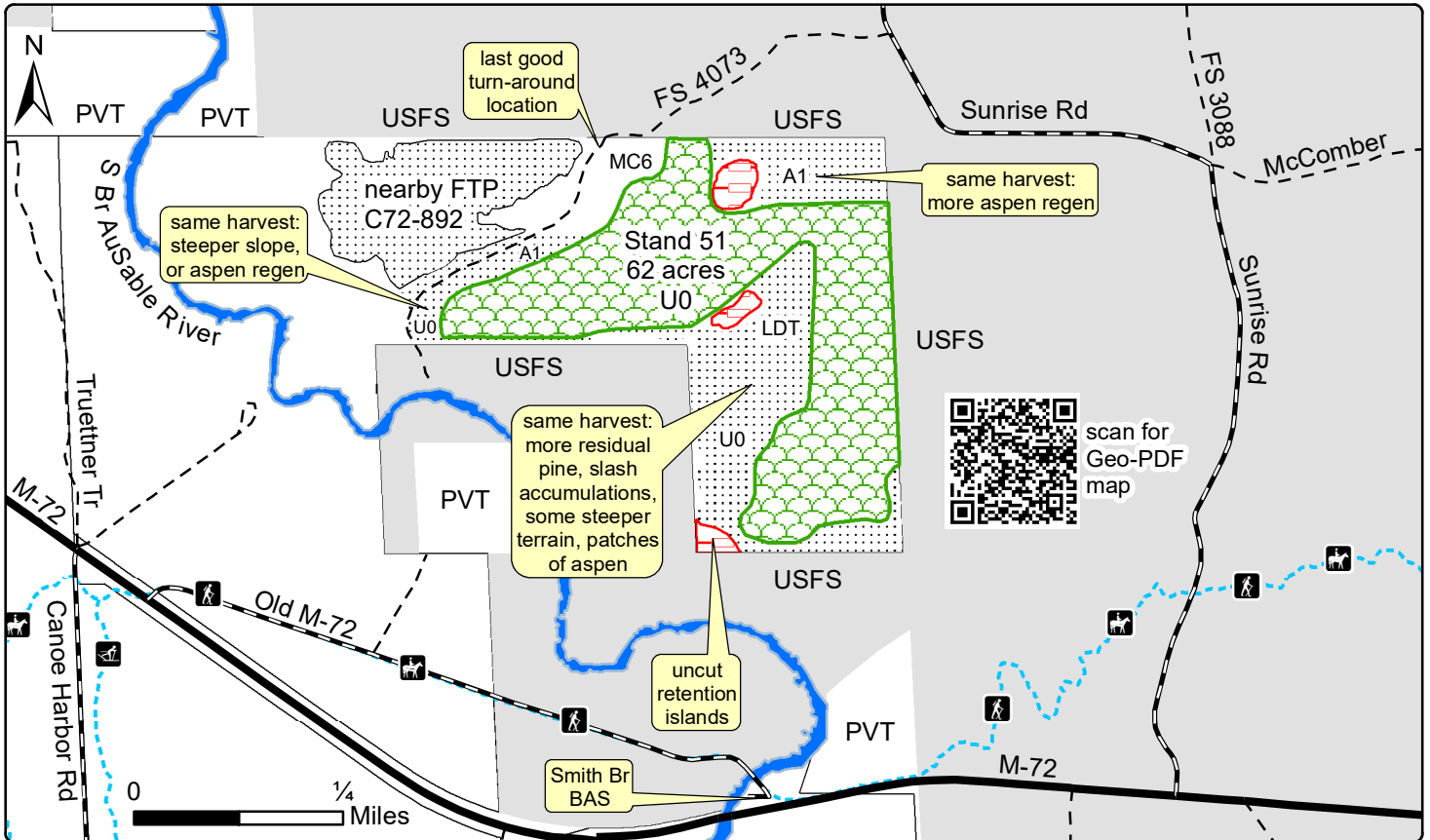

Comments: This harvest was set up with a natural regen objective. The natural regen largely failed, so operable portions were recently approved to be planted to red pine. The planned planting boundary shown on this FTP was approximated to exclude areas of the larger harvest that could be difficult to cultivate due to steeper slopes, heavier slash piles, more residual trees, or pockets of advanced aspen regen. This boundary is not set in stone. It can be varied from somewhat during cultivation if the trenchable area is found to be larger, except avoid creating a lot of doglegs in the planting boundary.
