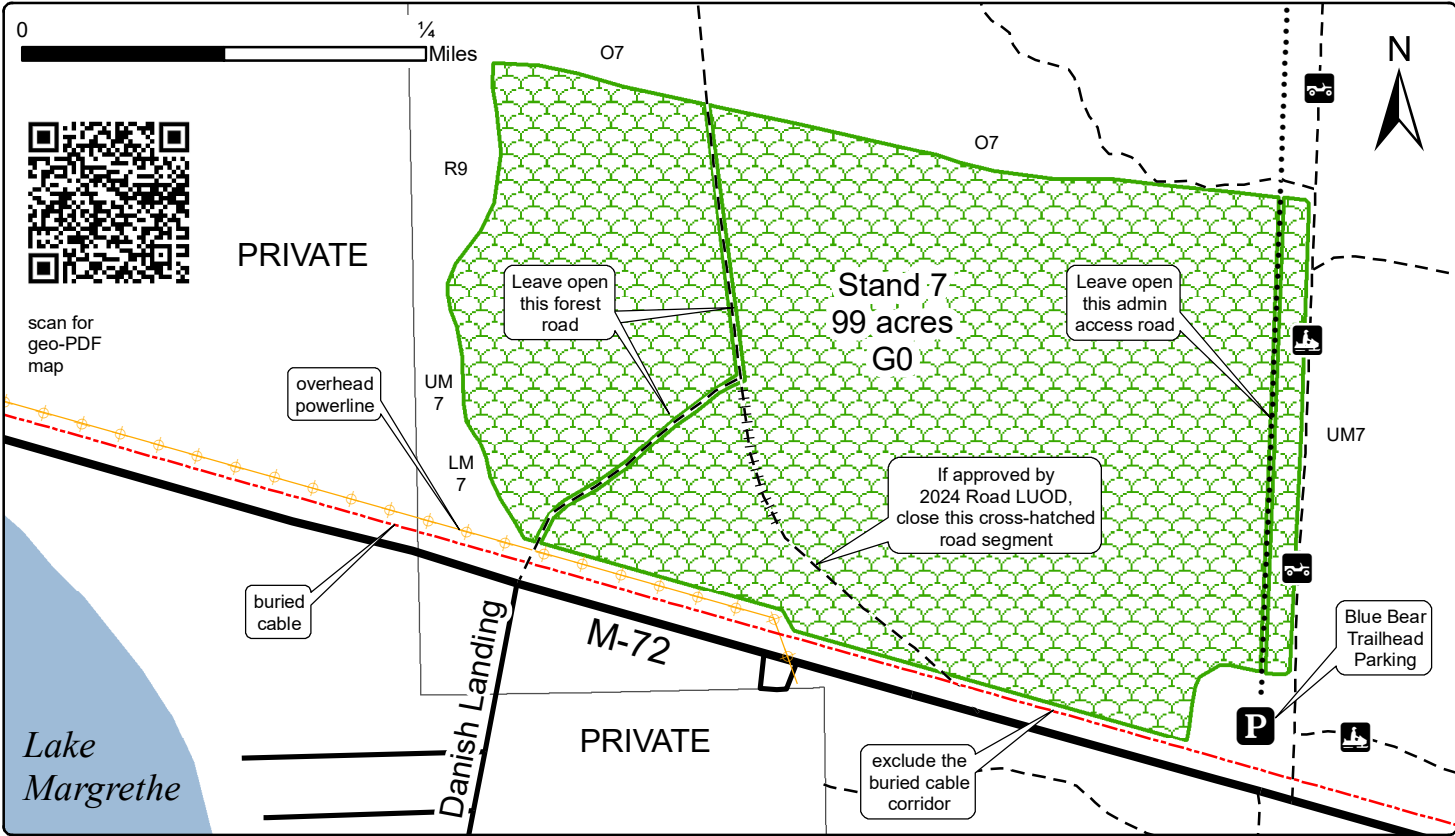

Comments: The stand had overmature oak cover with WP below. There was a fair amount of dead and down material from the declining oak, in addition to scattered tall stumps from a 2005 shelterwood harvest. One road segment in the west side of the FTP area is proposed for closure. If approved by Land Use Order of the Director (LUOD) in February 2024, cultivate through that segment to close it. That segment is symbolized with cross-hatching on the FTP map.
