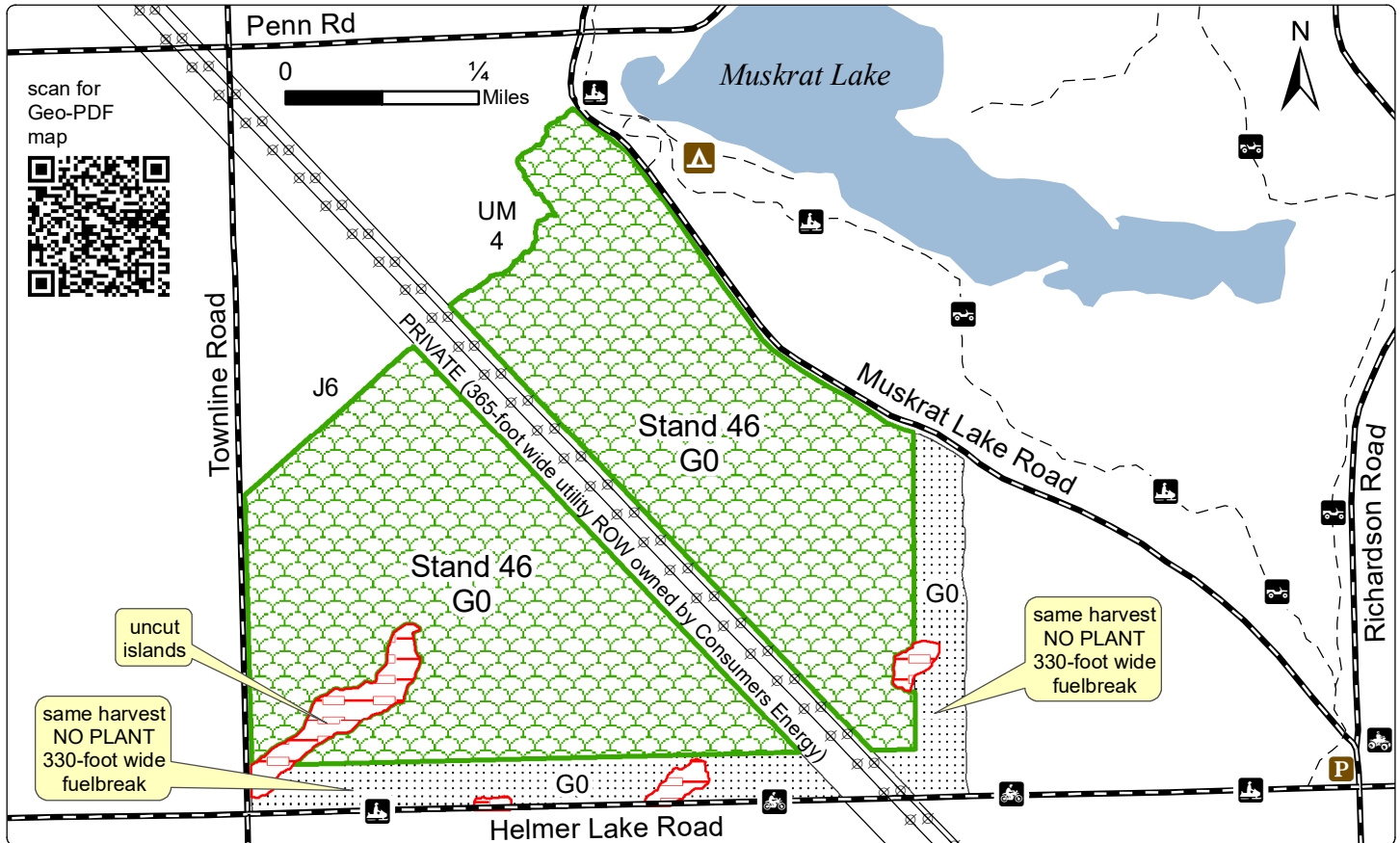

Comments: DO NOT trench or plant within the 365-foot wide privately-owned ROW that bisects the FTP area. The east ~215 feet of that ROW had been maintained in grass cover for decades. Consumers Energy cleared tree cover off the west ~150 feet of their corridor roughly ten years ago. Also DO NOT trench or plant w/in the 330-foot wide fuelbreaks that will be maintained open on the east and south sides of planting area. Trench through blocked temp access roads within planting area. Sale was primarily tree length harvested & chipped, however market conditions required production of clean chips at times. This resulted in some additional slash accumulation in the S & NE but that slash shouldn't impede trencher operation.
