




Description: Northwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 9, T 26 N, R 2 E, Big Creek Township, Oscoda County, Michigan.

Purpose of this survey is to delineate the exterior of the above described parcel, and to divide it into an East 1/2 and West 1/2.

This survey is based upon the monumentation of the U.S. G.L.O. Dependent Resurvey in 1935. Evidence of an unrecorded survey, reported to have been made about 1927, does not agree with the existing Government monuments. The Government surveyors disregarded the West 1/4 Corner and North 1/4 Corner as established by the 1927 survey. Thus, we disagree with the existing 1/2" Bar found at the Center of the Northwest 1/4, as shown on the attached map of survey.

1/2" Bars have been placed at all points shown as thus () Concrete plat monuments have been found at all points shown as thus () All bearings are based upon the West line of Section 9 as reported in the Government Survey of 1935 Scale: 1 inch equals 300 feet.

Lath have been placed at frequent intervals along the lines of this survey.
