B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

E-9 Corner common to Sections 20, 21, 28 and 29, T31N, R5W The Southwest corner of Section 21 was set using a three point control method. Due to the lack of any corner records, since the GLO survey, for $2+$ miles to the West this method is believed to be appropriate in this instance. The latitude of the corner position was determined proportionally between Corner E-5 and corner E-11, T31N, R5W. The change in departure between corners G-9 and F-9 was used determine the East-West position of the corner. A 1"x3' pipe with cap \# 43046 was set at the corner which falls approximately 100 feet South and 100 feet West of the southerly bank of the Jordan River. The river runs through wide flat bottom lands and likely has shifted course over the years. Consequently it was not felt acceptable to place the corner from GLO calls to the river. The GLO calls out the river 2.36 chains (155.8') East and on the random line 1 chain North. The corner was corrected approximately 36 feet West by the GLO surveyor and consequently the actual distance to the river North was likely more than 1 chain.
