

4. Will a survey allow harvest of timber that is being held from the market due to survey problems? What is the value of the proposed sale? Explain			
(i.e., give the compartment, year of entry, timber condition, etc.): Yes, this surveys will establish property boudaries for an upcoming timber sale. The sale will be approximately 80 acres, an approximate value of \$ 40,000. (Compt. 52047, Treatments: 52047033,52047037, 52047035, & 52047013, 2024 YOE, (Hardwood sawtimber & Mixed Pine pulpwood).			
5. Are there reasonable alternatives to a survey that will allow at least a partial or temporary solution? (Example: Reduce size of the sale, agreement with or notification of adjacent landowner until proper survey can be done, establish line yourself, etc.) Explain:			
A buffered timber sale boundary could be used to harvest this timber. However, the area being surveyed is being planted to red pine. So it is in the states best interest to maximize growing space and protect it's property interest with the adjacent landower.			
6. Other: Thre are not many other survey corners in this area. However there are records of corners along the south line of this section (SE corner, SW corner & E 1/16 corner on S line & E 1/4 corner)
