## BID INSTRUCTIONS (Ver. 06/23/2008):

- 1. <u>Bid Location, Date, and Time:</u> Bids must be received by the Unit Manager, Sault Ste. Marie Management Unit, <u>Naubinway Field Office</u>, PO Box 287, US 2, Naubinway, MI 49762, no later than 3:30 p.m. on <u>January 7, 2010</u>. For further information concerning this sale, contact the Unit Manager at 906-477-6048.
- 2. <u>Bidder's Qualifications:</u> Purchaser shall obtain workers compensation insurance to cover claims under Michigan's Worker's Disability Compensation Act of 1969 or similar employee benefit act of any other state applicable to an employee. If all or part of a timber sale was prepared by a private contractor, that contractor and that contractor's company are not permitted to bid on the timber sale contract. Bids will not be accepted from individuals or companies appearing on the DNR/FMFM No-Bid List. This list contains the names of purchasers who previously failed to execute a contract within 21-days or who have a history of poor performance.
- 3. Preparation of Sealed Bids: Bids shall be manually signed in ink; bid prices must be entered for each species and product in the Bid Price column for all material subject to bidding; and all fill-in blanks must be completed. If erasures or other changes appear on the forms, each erasure or change must be initialed by the person signing the bid.
- 4. <u>Submission of Sealed Bids</u>: Bid forms may be obtained from the Unit Manager. All bids must be submitted on the bid form and in an <u>envelope clearly identified</u> as described in this section. NOTE: Only one bid form per bid envelope. Sealed bids must be submitted to the Unit office designated in the prospectus and must be submitted at or prior to the time established in the prospectus. The envelope should show on the outside (a) that it is a "Bid for Timber," and (b) the sale name or number, and (c) the date and time of bid opening as shown in the prospectus. Bids received after the time specified in the sale prospectus are late bids and will be rejected.
- 5. Public Opening of Sealed Bids: If conditions permit, the sealed bids will be publicly opened and posted at the time and place set in the prospectus.
- 6. Award of Contract: Award of the contract will be made to the Bidder whose bid, conforming to the prospectus, is most advantageous to the State of Michigan on the basis of total value at rates bid for the estimated quantities. The State reserves the right to reject any bid or waive any minor irregularity in bids received. A written award mailed (or otherwise furnished) to the successful Bidder shall be deemed to result in a binding contract without further action by either party.
- 7. <u>Down Payment:</u> The Bidder to whom award is made must make a down payment within 21 days of the sale award. The amount of the down payment will be calculated as shown in the Bond and Payment Schedule of this prospectus. Only cash may be used to meet this requirement.
- 8. <u>Performance Security:</u> As guarantee of faithful performance, a cash bond, certificate of deposit, surety bond or irrevocable letter of credit (LOC) is required within 21 days of the sale award. The amount of the performance security is shown in the Bond and Payment Schedule of this prospectus. If an LOC or surety is used, the coverage must extend for at least 6 months beyond the contract expiration.
- 9. <u>Timber Sale Contract</u>: Additional conditions and requirements common to all timber sales are listed on the timber sale contract (R4031) and are available on line at <a href="https://www.michigan.gov/dnr">www.michigan.gov/dnr</a>. Contact the Unit Manager for additional information or a sample contract. Within 21 days of the date of the award letter, the bidder must sign the contract and provide the required down payment, performance security, and verification of worker's disability compensation. The down payment and performance security shall be in accordance with the provisions of the timber sale contract, in the sums stated in this prospectus. If these actions are not taken, then the Bidder, the Bidder's corporation, and the corporation's principals may not be permitted to bid on State timber sales for a period of 1 year. In addition, the Bidder certifies that if awarded this contract, the Bidder will complete the timber sale contract in accordance with its terms and any modifications thereof including requirements to purchase, cut, and remove the included timber by the termination date.

10. Disclaimer of Estimates and Bidder's Warranty of Inspection: Before submitting this bid, the Bidder is advised and cautioned to inspect the sale area, review the requirements of the sale contract, and take other steps as may be reasonably necessary to ascertain the location, estimated volumes, construction estimates, and operating costs of the proposed sale. Failure to do so will not relieve the Bidder from responsibility for completing the contract.

The Bidder warrants that this bid is submitted solely on the basis of the Bidder's examination and inspection of the quality and quantity of the timber offered for sale and the Bidder's opinion of the value thereof and the costs of recovery. No reliance should be placed on the State of Michigan's estimates of timber quality, quantity or costs of recovery. Bidder further acknowledges that the State of Michigan: (i) expressly disclaims any warranty of fitness of timber for any purpose; (ii) offers this timber as is without any warranty of quality (merchantability) or quantity and (iii) expressly disclaims any warranty as to the quantity or quality of timber sold.

11. Certification and Chain-of-Custody: Unless otherwise indicated in the contract under section 7 - Other Conditions of the Sale Specific Conditions & Requirements, the area encompassed by this timber sale is certified to the standards of the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) - Certificate #SCS-FM/COC-090N and the Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI) - Certificate # NSF-SFIS-5Y031-S1. Forest products from this sale may be delivered to the mill as "FSC and / or SFI certified" as long as the contractor hauling the forest products is chain-of-custody (COC) certified or covered under a COC certificate from the destination mill. The purchaser is responsible for maintaining COC after leaving the sale area.

#### 1 - Sale Area

#### 1.2 - Boundaries

## 1.2.1 - Painted boundaries (6/05)

The sale boundary is marked and identified by red paint. Interior Payment Unit boundaries are marked with red paint. Red painted trees designating an interior Payment Unit boundary are only to be cut when all surrounding Payment Units have been paid.

## 2 - Timber Specifications

#### 2.1 - Included Timber

## 2.1.1 - Clearcut unit(s) with unmerchantable trees (2/04)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1, 2 & 3, cut all deciduous trees that are two (2) inches or more in diameter measured at a point of four and one-half (4-1/2) feet above ground level regardless of merchantability and cut all coniferous trees that are four (4) inches or more in diameter measured at a point of four and one-half (4-1/2) feet above ground level regardless of merchantability, except for leave trees identified in accordance with 2.4.1 - Leave trees, within clearcutting unit boundaries, are not Included Timber and are to be protected.

## 2.2 - Utilization

## 2.2.4 - Skidding length (2/04)

Skidding of unlimbed tops or lengths over 17 feet is not permissible in Units 2 & 3 unless approved by the Unit Manager or their representative.

## 2.4 - Special Protection

## 2.4.1 - Leave trees (1/09)

Leave all red pine, white pine, cedar and yellow birch.

## 4 - Transportation

## 4.1 - Construction

## 4.1.7 - Road closure (4/07)

All new roads built into the sale must be blocked to vehicle traffic upon completion of the sale. In general, this will require the placement of berms, stumps, slash and brush along 20 feet of the new road system. These roads must be rebderedd impassable to cars and trucks. Contact the sale administrator for specific details of design and placement.

## 4.2 - Maintenance

4.2.1 - Hauling restriction (3/07)

Hauling may be restricted on forest roads by the Unit Manager or their representative. The restriction may occur during peak summertime camping conditions.

## 5 - Operations

#### 5.1 - Notification

## 5.1.1 - Pre-sale conference (2/08)

A pre-sale conference on site between the Purchaser and sale administrator is required prior to beginning any operations. The Unit Manager or their representative must be contacted at least 10 days in advance to schedule the conference.

## 5.1.4 - Post-sale conference (2/04)

A post-sale conference on site between the Purchaser and sale administrator is required 5 days prior to the completion of active logging operations to determine clean-up and repair of landings, road edges, and the fulfillment of other contract specifications.

## 5.2 - Conduct of Operations

#### 5.2.1 - Slash

#### 5.2.1.2 - Slash Removal

5.2.1.2.1 - Slash removal, right-of-way (12/04)

All slash must be removed at least 50 feet from the cleared right-of-way of Big Knob and Rock River Roads.

## 5.2.2 - Hazard Trees/Snags

5.2.2.1 - Den trees (2/04)

Obvious hollow and/or den trees shall be protected and left standing unless they are a safety hazard.

#### 5.2.4 - Dead and Down Creation

5.2.4.3 - Dead and down creation, dead trees (6/07)

Except as provided for in General Condition and Requirement 5.2.2, no dead trees, standing or down, are to be cut, skidded, or processed.

## 5.2.22 - Operating Caution

## 5.2.22.1 - Operating caution (12/04)

It is recommended, but not required, that within Payment Unit(s) 1, 2 & 3, cutting, skidding, and hauling occur during dry summer or frozen winter conditions. This restriction is because of hilly conditions (Units 2 & 3), the presence of low ground pockets (Unit 2) and rock/fissures (Unit 1).

## 5.2.37 - No decking areas (12/08)

No decking is allowed within 50 feet of Big Knob Road, without permission of the Unit Manager or their representative.

## 5.2.38 - No decking against live trees (2/04)

Cut products may not be decked against unmarked or designated leave trees.

## 5.4 - Soil Protection

## 5.4.1 - Rutting restriction, general (5/08)

Operations are to cease immediately if equipment and weather conditions result in rutting of roads which is 12 inches or greater in depth and 50 feet in length. In addition, operations are to cease immediately if equipment and weather conditions result in rutting on skid trails which is 12 inches or greater in depth and 50 feet in length. The Unit Manager or their representative may restrict hauling and/or skidding if ruts exceed the specified depth. With the Unit Manager or their representative's approval, the Purchaser may return to the area when the weather conditions have changed and/or the risk of rutting has decreased.

## 5.4.6 - Wet area protection (9/05)

No harvesting operations, including skidding and felling, are to take place within 100 feet of the vernal pond areas or drainages. Care must be taken by the purchaser to identify and avoid operating in these areas of the timber sale.

## 5.8 - Protection of Endangered Species

## 5.8.5 - Protection of raptor nests (9/05)

All trees with raptor nests will be protected if found during harvesting operations. Notification will be made to the Unit Manager and Wildlife Biologist so an on-site evaluation and recommendation can be made, if necessary.

## 6 - Safety and Fire Prevention

## 6.2 - Signing

## 6.2.1 - Road posting (9/08)

The purchaser is responsible for posting and maintaining caution signs on Big Knob Road prior to beginning operations. The road must be posted at appropriate distances from the sale area to warn of logging activity and truck traffic. Signs must be removed when harvest operations are suspended or completed. The Purchaser will provide these signs for use on State-owned land.

## 7.3 - Contract Modifications

#### 7.3.1 - Emerald Ash Borer

## 7.3.1.2 - Emerald ash borer, ash or firewood on sale (2/05)



## 1 - Sale Area

#### 1.2 - Boundaries

## 1.2.1 - Painted boundaries (12/08)

The sale boundary is marked and identified by red paint. Exterior sale boundary lines against state are marked with red paint. Do not cut painted boundary line trees unless also marked with orange paint.

## 2 - Timber Specifications

## 2.1 - Included Timber

## 2.1.1 - Clearcut unit(s) with unmerchantable trees (12/08)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1, 3 and 4, cut all trees that are two (2) inches or more in diameter measured at a point of four and one-half (4-1/2) feet above ground level regardless of merchantability. Leave trees identified in accordance with 2.4.1 - Leave trees, within clearcutting unit boundaries, are not Included Timber and are to be protected.

## 2.1.3 - Cut tree marked unit(s) (12/08)

Within Payment Unit(s) 2, all trees are designated for cutting when marked with orange paint above and below stump height, regardless of merchantability.

## 2.4 - Special Protection

## 2.4.1 - Leave trees (1/09)

With in unit 1, 3, and 4 leave all white pine, hemlock, cedar and cherry.

## 4 - Transportation

#### 4.1 - Construction

## 4.1.7 - Road closure (4/07)

All new roads built into the sale must be blocked to vehicle traffic upon completion of the sale. Overgrown roads that are reopened shall be considered new roads. In general, this will require placement of berms, stumps, slash and brush along 30 feet of the new road system. These roads must be rendered impassable to cars and trucks. Contact the sale administrator for specific details of design and placement.

#### 5.1 - Notification

## 5.1.1 - Pre-sale conference (12/08)

A pre-sale conference on site between the Purchaser and sale administrator is required prior to beginning any operations. The Unit Manager or his/her representative must be contacted at least 2 days in advance to schedule the conference.

## 5.1.4 - Post-sale conference (2/04)

A post-sale conference on site between the Purchaser and sale administrator is required 5 days prior to the completion of active logging operations to determine clean-up and repair of landings, road edges, and the fulfillment of other contract specifications.

## 5.2 - Conduct of Operations

#### 5.2.1 - Slash

#### 5.2.1.2 - Slash Removal

#### 5.2.1.2.1 - Slash removal, right-of-way (12/04)

All slash must be removed at least 10 feet from the cleared right-of-way of forest roads.

## 5.2.3 - Operating Restrictions

## 5.2.3.3 - Bark slippage restriction (1/09)

Within Payment Unit(s) 2, unless changed by written agreement, cutting and skidding are not permitted during the period of May 1st to June 30th. This restriction is because of bark slippage.

## 5.2.3.9 - Beech hauling restriction (8/09)

American beech wood products with bark still attached, other than chips, are not to be transported from stands infested with beech bark disease to or through uninfested beech areas the lower peninsula from July 15 to November 15. Beech scale is mobile at this time of year and can move from infested wood to live beech. (See Map of current beech scale distribution on the DNR Forest Health Website, www.michigan.gov/dnr.)

## 5.2.4 - Dead and Down Creation

## 5.2.4.3 - Dead and down creation, dead trees (6/07)

Except as provided for in General Condition and Requirement 5.2.2, no dead trees, standing or down, are to be cut, skidded, or processed.

## 5.2.22 - Operating Caution

## 5.2.22.1 - Operating caution (12/04)

It is recommended, but not required, that within Payment Unit(s) 3 and 4, cutting and skidding occur during dry summer or frozen winter conditions. This restriction is low ground conditions.

## 5.2.37 - No decking areas (12/08)

No decking is allowed within 50 feet of Borgstrom Road and Old Hendricks Roadwithout permission of the Unit Manager or his/her representative.

5.2.38 - No decking against live trees (2/04)

Cut products may not be decked against unmarked or designated leave trees.

## 5.4 - Soil Protection

## 5.4.1 - Rutting restriction, general (1/09)

Operations are to cease immediately if equipment and weather conditions result in rutting of roads and skid trails which is 12 inches or greater in depth and 50 feet in length. The Unit Manager or his/her representative may restrict hauling and/or skidding if ruts exceed the specified depth. With the Unit Manager or his/her representative's approval, the Purchaser may return to the area when the risk of rutting has decreased.

## 5.8.5 - Protection of raptor nests (12/08)

All trees with raptor nests will be protected if found during harvesting operations. Notification will be made to the Unit Manager and Wildlife Biologist so an on-site evaluation and recommendation can be made, if necessary.




