2. Bidder's Qualifications (1/11)

Purchaser shall obtain workers compensation insurance to cover claims under Michigan's Worker's Disability Compensation Act of 1969 or similar employee benefit act of any other state applicable to an employee. If all or part of a timber sale was prepared by a private contractor, that contractor and that contractor's company are not permitted to bid on the timber sale contract. Bids will not be accepted from individuals or companies appearing on the DNRE/FMD No-Bid List. This list contains the names of purchasers who previously failed to execute a contract within 21-days or who have a history of poor performance.

3. Preparation of Sealed Bids (1/11)

Bids shall be manually signed in ink; bid prices must be entered for each species and product in the Bid Price column for all material subject to bidding; and all fill-in blanks must be completed. If erasures or other changes appear on the forms, each erasure or change must be initialed by the person signing the bid.

4. Submission of Sealed Bids (1/11)

Bid forms may be obtained from the Unit Manager. All bids must be submitted on the bid form and in an envelope clearly identified as described in this section. NOTE: Only one bid form per bid envelope. Sealed bids must be submitted to the Unit office designated in the prospectus and must be submitted at or prior to the time established in the prospectus. The envelope should show on the outside (a) that it is a "Bid for Timber," and (b) the sale name or number, and (c) the date and time of bid opening as shown in the prospectus. Bids received after the time specified in the sale prospectus are late bids and will be rejected.

5. Public Opening of Sealed Bids (1/11)

If conditions permit, the sealed bids will be publicly opened and posted at the time and place set in the prospectus.

6. Award of Contract (1/11)

Award of the contract will be made to the Bidder whose bid, conforming to the prospectus, is most advantageous to the State of Michigan on the basis of total value at rates bid for the estimated quantities. The State reserves the right to reject any bid or waive any minor irregularity in bids received. A written award mailed (or otherwise furnished) to the successful Bidder shall be deemed to result in a binding contract without further action by either party.

7. Down Payment (1/11)

The Bidder to whom award is made must make a down payment within 21 days of the sale award. The amount of the down payment will be calculated as shown in the Bond and Payment Schedule of this prospectus. Only cash may be used to meet this requirement.

8. Performance Security (1/11)

As guarantee of faithful performance, a cash bond, certificate of deposit, surety bond or irrevocable letter of credit (LOC) is required within 21 days of the sale award. The amount of the performance security is shown in the Bond and Payment Schedule of this prospectus. If an LOC or surety is used, the coverage must extend for at least 6 months beyond the contract expiration.

9. Timber Sale Contract (1/11)

Additional conditions and requirements common to all timber sales are listed on the timber sale contract (R4031) and are available on line at www.michigan.gov/dnr. Within 21 days of the date of the award letter, the bidder must sign the contract and provide the required down payment, performance security, and verification of worker's disability compensation. The down payment and performance security shall be in accordance with the provisions of the timber sale contract, in the sums stated in this prospectus. If these actions are not taken, then the Bidder, the Bidder's corporation, and the corporation's principals may not be permitted to bid on State timber sales for a period of 1 year. 10. Disclaimer of Estimates and Bidder's Warranty of Inspection (1/11)

Before submitting this bid, the Bidder is advised and cautioned to inspect the sale area, review the requirements of the sale contract, and take other steps as may be reasonably necessary to ascertain the location, estimated volumes, construction estimates, and operating costs of the proposed sale. Failure to do so will not relieve the Bidder from responsibility for completing the contract.

The Bidder warrants that this bid is submitted solely on the basis of the Bidder's examination and inspection of the quality and quantity of the timber offered for sale and the Bidder's opinion of the value thereof and the costs of recovery. 1 - Sale Area

1.2 - Boundaries

1.2.1 - Painted boundaries (12/08)

The sale boundary and Payment Unit boundaries are marked and identified by red and yellow paint. Exterior sale boundary lines against state are marked with red paint. Interior Payment Unit boundaries are marked with yellow paint. Do not cut yellow painted boundary line trees between Payment Units 1 and 3 unless also marked with orange paint. Yellow painted trees between Payment Units 1 and 2 and yellow and orange painted trees between Payment Units 1 and 3 may be harvested but only when the surrounding Payment Units have been paid.

2 - Timber Specifications

2.1 - Included Timber

2.1.1 - Clearcut unit(s) with unmerchantable trees (4/09)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1 and 2, cut all species of trees that are three (3) inches or more in diameter measured at a point four and one-half (4-1/2) feet above ground level regardless of merchantability; except do not cut oak, cedar, and hemlock.

2.1.3 - Cut tree marked unit(s) (12/08)

Within Payment Unit(s) 3, all trees are designated for cutting when marked with orange paint above and below stump height, regardless of merchantability. In addition cut all aspen unless they are marked with an orange X.

2.1.11 - Description of timber note (2/04)

Note that the mixed hardwood pulpwood volume contains 70 cords of basswood. The balsam fir pulpwood contains mostly balsam fir, but there is about 30 cords of spruce and a couple cords of tamarack. The mixed hardwood sawlog volume contains ash, sugar maple, red maple, and white birch.

2.2 - Utilization

2.2.4 - Skidding length (2/09)

Skidding of lengths over 17 feet is not permissible within unit 3.

3 - Payments

3.3 - Pre-measured Sales

3.3.4 - Dividing payment units (12/08)

Payment unit(s) \$14,000 in value or greater may be divided at the request of the purchaser and upon approval of the Unit Manager. Dividing payment units is a contract modification which requires a Timber Sale Contract Supplement.

4 - Transportation

4.1 - Construction

4.1.8 - Road work (1) (8/07)

The following road work is required: The Small Creek Road needs to be opened up and widened and rendered passable to two wheel drive vehicles. During the pre-sale meeting we will review all road work that needs to be done. The contractor needs to purchase and install two new corrugated steel culverts. One culvert needs to be 18" X 24' and the other one needs to be 24" X 24', the approximate locations for each are shown on the timber sale map. The 24 inch culvert will be replacing an existing culvert that has been crushed.

A total of 160 yards of gravel will need to be hauled and spread by the contractor. 20 to 30 yards of gravel will need to be placed over and on the approaches of the 18" culvert. 80 yards of gravel will need to placed over and on the approaches of the 24" culvert. An additional 30 to 40 yards will need to be placed over the culvert and the approaches near the sales west

line.

The contractor might also need to purchase and install an extension for the existing culvert so fill does not enter the creek. A few low areas along the remaining part of the road will need some gravel as well, so this is where the additional gravel will be placed. The gravel is available from a state pit that is within a mile of the sale area. All road work must be completed prior to any harvesting activities taking place. No DEQ permits are necessary for either of the culvert installations.

4.2 - Maintenance

4.2.1 - Hauling restriction (12/08)

Hauling may be restricted on forest roads by the Unit Manager or his/her representative. The restriction may occur during spring breakup or during other wet weather conditions.

5.2 - Conduct of Operations

5.2.3 - Operating Restrictions

5.2.3.3 - Bark slippage restriction (3/09)

Within Payment Unit(s) 3, unless changed by written agreement, cutting and skidding are not permitted during the period of April 15 to July 15. This restriction is because of bark slippage.

5.2.32 - Decking/landing restoration (9/10)


All decking and landing areas must have the surface area restored to a condition equal to or better than before. This is to insure the proper regeneration of the stand.

5.4 - Soil Protection

5.4.1 - Rutting restriction, general (1/09)

Operations are to cease immediately if equipment and weather conditions result in rutting of roads and skid trails which is 12 inches or greater in depth and 50 feet in length. The Unit Manager or his/her representative may restrict hauling and/or skidding if ruts exceed the specified depth. With the Unit Manager or his/her representative's approval, the Purchaser may return to the area when the risk of rutting has decreased.

1.2 - Boundaries

1.2.1 - Painted boundaries (12/08)

The sale boundary and Payment Unit boundaries are marked and identified by blue, red and yellow paint. Exterior sale boundary lines against private property are marked with blue paint. Exterior sale boundary lines against state are marked with red paint. Interior Payment Unit boundaries are marked with yellow paint. 2 - Timber Specifications

2.1 - Included Timber

2.1.1 - Clearcut unit(s) with unmerchantable trees (4/09)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1 and 2, cut all trees that are three (3) inches or more in diameter measured at a point four and one-half (4-1/2) feet above ground level regardless of merchantability; except do not cut oak, white pine, red pine, and beech. There is also a 1.8 acre reserve area between units 1 and 2 that is not to be harvested. Reserve areas identified in accordance with 2.4.3 - Reserve areas, within clearcutting unit boundaries, are not Included Timber and are to be protected.

2.1.11 - Description of timber note (2/04)

Note that the mixed hardwood pulpwood volume contains about 82 cords of basswood. The mixed softwood volume contains about 90 cords of balsam fir, 71 cords of spruce, and 2 cords of tamarack.

2.4 - Special Protection

2.4.3 - Reserve areas (1/09)

The Purchaser shall protect reserve areas from damage by the Purchaser's operations. Reserve areas are marked with a red boundary line. The Purchaser shall not cut live or dead trees within reserve areas.

3.3 - Pre-measured Sales

3.3.4 - Dividing payment units (12/08)

Payment unit(s) \$14,000 in value or greater may be divided at the request of the purchaser and upon approval of the Unit Manager. Dividing payment units is a contract modification which requires a Timber Sale Contract Supplement.

4 - Transportation

4.1 - Construction

4.1.8 - Road work (1) (8/07)

The following road work is required and must be completed prior to any harvesting activities taking place. The contractor must purchase and install a 12" X 24' corrugated steel culvert. The culvert must have a minimum of 12 inches of gravel placed over it. The contractor will need to haul and spread 30 yards of gravel and place it over the culvert and on the approaches. Another 40 yards of gravel will need to be hauled and spread by the contractor and placed in a low area on the south access road.

During the pre-sale meeting we will review all of the required road work. The gravel is available from a state pit, that is about 5 miles away. No DEQ permit is necessary for the culvert installation.

4.2 - Maintenance

4.2.1 - Hauling restriction (12/08)

Hauling may be restricted on forest roads by the Unit Manager or his/her representative. The restriction may occur during spring breakup or during other wet weather conditions.

5 - Operations

5.2 - Conduct of Operations

5.2.1 - Slash

5.2.1.1 - Slash within sale area (2/04)

No trees are to be felled outside the sale area and all slash is to be kept at least 10 feet back from the blue paint line.

5.2.32 - Decking/landing restoration (9/10)

All decking and landing areas must have the surface area restored to a condition equal to or better than before. This is to insure the proper regeneration of the stand.

5.4 - Soil Protection

5.4.1 - Rutting restriction, general (1/09)

Operations are to cease immediately if equipment and weather conditions result in rutting of roads and skid trails which is 12 inches or greater in depth and 50 feet in length. The Unit Manager or his/her representative may restrict hauling and/or skidding if ruts exceed the specified depth. With the Unit Manager or his/her representative's approval, the Purchaser may return to the area when the risk of rutting has decreased.

6 - Safety and Fire Prevention

6.2 - Signing

6.2.1 - Road posting (9/09)

The purchaser is responsible for posting and maintaining caution signs on the DeTemple Road prior to beginning operations. The road must be posted at appropriate distances from the sale area to warn of logging activity and truck traffic. Signs must be removed when harvest operations are suspended or completed. The Purchaser will provide these signs.

7 - Other Conditions

7.5 - Loss

7.5.1 - Deteriorating timber (7/09)

The sale area has received damage from the spruce budworm. Because of this the spruce and balsam fir is dying out. The purchaser should harvest the wood as soon as possible. The Department of Natural Resources is held free of responsibility of any further damage or deterioration due to delay in harvesting.

2.1.1 - Clearcut unit(s) with unmerchantable trees (4/09)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1 to 4, cut all trees that are three (3) inches or more in diameter measured at a point four and one-half (4-1/2) feet above ground level regardless of merchantability, except as follows: In Payment Units 1, 2, and 3 do not cut cedar, oak, and trees marked with green paint. In Payment Unit 4 do not cut red and white pine greater than 14 inches at DBH. In addition, all dead standing timber should be cut and removed, except leave two to three dead snags per acre.

2.1.11 - Description of timber note (2/04)

Note that the spruce budworm has been affecting the spruce and balsam fir for a decade in the sale area. So there is an abundance of dead trees along with a large amount of trees with very few living branches. All trees with any living branches were cruised along with any recently dead trees that are sound enough to market as pulpwood.

2.2 - Utilization

2.2.2 - Chipping required (1/11)

All units must be chip harvested to facilitate aspen regeneration and lower the potential for a wildland fire.
