#### 2. Bidder's Qualifications (2/12)

Purchaser shall obtain workers compensation insurance to cover claims under Michigan's Worker's Disability Compensation Act of 1969 or similar employee benefit act of any other state applicable to an employee. If all or part of a timber sale was prepared by a private contractor, that contractor and that contractor's company are not permitted to bid on the timber sale contract. Bids will not be accepted from individuals or companies appearing on the DNR/FRD No-Bid List. This list contains the names of purchasers who previously failed to execute a contract within 21-days or who have a history of poor performance.

# 3. Preparation of Sealed Bids (1/11)

Bids shall be manually signed in ink; bid prices must be entered for each species and product in the Bid Price column for all material subject to bidding; and all fill-in blanks must be completed. If erasures or other changes appear on the forms, each erasure or change must be initialed by the person signing the bid.

# 4. Submission of Sealed Bids (6/11)

Bid forms may be obtained from the Unit Manager. All bids must be submitted on the bid form and in an envelope clearly identified as described in this section. NOTE: Only one bid form per bid envelope. Sealed bids must be submitted to the Unit office designated in the prospectus and must be submitted at or prior to the time established in the prospectus. The envelope should show on the outside (a) the sale name or number and (b) the date and time of bid opening as shown in the prospectus. Bids received after the time specified in the sale prospectus are late bids and will be rejected.

# 5. Public Opening of Sealed Bids (1/11)

If conditions permit, the sealed bids will be publicly opened and posted at the time and place set in the prospectus.

#### 6. Award of Contract (1/11)

Award of the contract will be made to the Bidder whose bid, conforming to the prospectus, is most advantageous to the State of Michigan on the basis of total value at rates bid for the estimated quantities. The State reserves the right to reject any bid or waive any minor irregularity in bids received. A written award mailed (or otherwise furnished) to the successful Bidder shall be deemed to result in a binding contract without further action by either party.

#### 7. Down Payment (1/11)

The Bidder to whom award is made must make a down payment within 21 days of the sale award. The amount of the down payment will be calculated as shown in the Bond and Payment Schedule of this prospectus. Only cash may be used to meet this requirement.

# 8. Performance Security (1/11)

As guarantee of faithful performance, a cash bond, certificate of deposit, surety bond or irrevocable letter of credit (LOC) is required within 21 days of the sale award. The amount of the performance security is shown in the Bond and Payment Schedule of this prospectus. If an LOC or surety is used, the coverage must extend for at least 6 months beyond the contract expiration.

#### 10. Disclaimer of Estimates and Bidder's Warranty of Inspection (1/11)

#### 1.2 - Boundaries

### 1.2.1 - Painted boundaries (12/08)

The sale boundary is marked and identified by red paint.

#### 2 - Timber Specifications

#### 2.1 - Included Timber

#### 2.1.4 - Species designation unit(s) (12/08)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1, all sugar maple and oak trees that have more than 40% crown mortality are designated for cutting. All red maple and cherry is to be left uncut and undamaged. The 40% crown mortality will be discussed at the Pre-Bid Meeting and the Pre-Sale Meeting as well.

Mixed hardwood pulp will be scaled and paid for at \$15/cord, mixed hardwood bolts (8-10" small end inside bark diameter and possibly larger diameters with defect that will not make a log quality product) will be paid for at \$25/cord, and mixed hardwood logs will be paid for at the bid price per MBF.

#### 2.1.11 - Description of timber note (2/04)

Note that volumes were estimated using 8 cords of pulp, 2 cords of bolts and .5 MBF per acre. Actual volumes will likely vary however it is a scale sale.

#### 2.2 - Utilization

#### 2.2.6 - Roundwood operation required (5/07)

The skidding of whole trees or tree segments with limbs attached is prohibited. All products must be produced as roundwood and forwarded to existing roads or landing areas in final product length. This is to minimize damage to advanced maple and cherry regeneration.

# 3.4.1 - Damaged timber (6/05)

General Condition and Requirement 3.4 Damaged Timber, defines liquidated damages for undesignated live merchantable trees which are cut or injured. In addition, extreme care should be taken to avoid damage to tree seedlings and saplings. Damage to residual trees (defined as breaking of the cambium layer, broken tops or bending of trees from their natural position) is not acceptable.

#### 4 - Transportation

#### 4.1 - Construction

#### 4.1.4 - Timber removed for construction (12/09)

Trees cut or damaged in the process of pre-approved road, landing or skid trail construction will be decked in an area separate from other designated timber and not removed until measured by the sale administrator. Payment will be made at the specified Purchase Unit Price.

#### 4.1.7 - Road closure (10/11)

All new roads built into the sale must be blocked to vehicle traffic upon completion of the sale. In general, this will require constructing a four (4') foot high berm of stumps and logs covered with earth. Stumps and brush must be placed along the remainder of the trail where they are readily available.

#### 5.1 - Notification

#### 5.1.1 - Pre-sale conference (10/11)

A pre-sale conference on site between the Purchaser and sale administrator is required prior to beginning any operations to determine scale locations, landing and road locations and to go over the sale specifications. The Unit Manager or his/her representative must be contacted at least 5 days in advance to schedule the conference.

#### 5.2.3.1 - Operating restrictions (9/11)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1, unless changed by written agreement, cutting and skidding are limited to July 1st through leaf drop. This restriction is to minimize further damage during bark slippage and to aid in determining the trees with 40% or more top mortality.

# 5.2.38 - No decking against live trees (2/04)

Cut products may not be decked against unmarked or designated leave trees.

# 5.2.39 - ORV trail/route protection (1/09)

There is an ORV trail shown on the Timber Sale Map. Designated dead trees with orange ORV markers should be cut off above the orange marker leaving the bottom portion of the tree intact. Maintain a 20 foot wide slash, debris, and rut free zone daily using the ORV trail or route as the centerline. Do not run equipment down the ORV trail or route. Skidding across the trail or route may only occur in locations approved by the sale administrator. If portions of the ORV route (Merita Ln) are used for trucking they must be restored to as good or better condition than they were prior to the timber sale use.
