#### 2. Bidder's Qualifications (2/12)

Purchaser shall obtain workers compensation insurance to cover claims under Michigan's Worker's Disability Compensation Act of 1969 or similar employee benefit act of any other state applicable to an employee. If all or part of a timber sale was prepared by a private contractor, that contractor and that contractor's company are not permitted to bid on the timber sale contract. Bids will not be accepted from individuals or companies appearing on the DNR/FRD No-Bid List. This list contains the names of purchasers who previously failed to execute a contract within 21-days or who have a history of poor performance.

#### 3. Preparation of Sealed Bids (1/11)

Bids shall be manually signed in ink; bid prices must be entered for each species and product in the Bid Price column for all material subject to bidding; and all fill-in blanks must be completed. If erasures or other changes appear on the forms, each erasure or change must be initialed by the person signing the bid.

#### 4. Submission of Sealed Bids (6/11)

Bid forms may be obtained from the Unit Manager. All bids must be submitted on the bid form and in an envelope clearly identified as described in this section. NOTE: Only one bid form per bid envelope. Sealed bids must be submitted to the Unit office designated in the prospectus and must be submitted at or prior to the time established in the prospectus. The envelope should show on the outside (a) the sale name or number and (b) the date and time of bid opening as shown in the prospectus. Bids received after the time specified in the sale prospectus are late bids and will be rejected.

# 5. Public Opening of Sealed Bids (1/11)

If conditions permit, the sealed bids will be publicly opened and posted at the time and place set in the prospectus.

# 6. Award of Contract (1/11)

Award of the contract will be made to the Bidder whose bid, conforming to the prospectus, is most advantageous to the State of Michigan on the basis of total value at rates bid for the estimated quantities. The State reserves the right to reject any bid or waive any minor irregularity in bids received. A written award mailed (or otherwise furnished) to the successful Bidder shall be deemed to result in a binding contract without further action by either party.

#### 7. Down Payment (1/11)

The Bidder to whom award is made must make a down payment within 21 days of the sale award. The amount of the down payment will be calculated as shown in the Bond and Payment Schedule of this prospectus. Only cash may be used to meet this requirement.

#### 8. Performance Security (1/11)

As guarantee of faithful performance, a cash bond, certificate of deposit, surety bond or irrevocable letter of credit (LOC) is required within 21 days of the sale award. The amount of the performance security is shown in the Bond and Payment Schedule of this prospectus. If an LOC or surety is used, the coverage must extend for at least 6 months beyond the contract expiration.

# 9. Timber Sale Contract (10/12)

#### 10. Disclaimer of Estimates and Bidder's Warranty of Inspection (1/11)

Before submitting this bid, the Bidder is advised and cautioned to inspect the sale area, review the requirements of the sale contract, and take other steps as may be reasonably necessary to ascertain the location, estimated volumes, construction estimates, and operating costs of the proposed sale. Failure to do so will not relieve the Bidder from responsibility for completing the contract.

The Bidder warrants that this bid is submitted solely on the basis of the Bidder's examination and inspection of the quality and quantity of the timber offered for sale and the Bidder's opinion of the value thereof and the costs of recovery. No reliance should be placed on the State of Michigan's estimates of timber quality, quantity or costs of recovery. # 11. Certification and Chain-of-Custody (10/11)

#### 1 - Sale Area

#### 1.2 - Boundaries

#### 1.2.1 - Painted boundaries (12/08)

The sale boundary is marked and identified by red paint. Exterior sale boundary lines against state are marked with red paint.

#### 2 - Timber Specifications

#### 2.1 - Included Timber

# 2.1.4 - Species designation unit(s) (12/08)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1 and 2, all oak marked with orange paint is designated for cutting. Units 1 and 2 contain several epi-centers of oak wilt that are being treated per the specifications listed below.

In addition, within units 1 and 2 cut all red oak and aspen greater than three (3) inches in diameter.

All wood designated for cutting in units 6 and 7 must be cut by April 1, 2013 and all wood must be skid and decked by April 15, 2013. Also, all oak must be hauled off site by April 15, 2013.

- A. Within units 1 and 2; oak trees marked with orange paint must be harvested and removed prior to April 1, 2013.
- B. Oak trees marked with orange paint must be cut and removed from an individual polygon within a payment unit prior to cutting any unmarked oak in that polygon. Orange painted marked oak may not be mixed with the unmarked oak.
- C. The contractor must inform the Timber Sale Administrator when cutting of the marked oak trees is completed in a payment unit prior to cutting any other trees in that payment unit.
- D. Oak marked with orange paint must be chipped, taken to a wood processing facility, or sawn into dimensional lumber products at a mill by April 15, 2013. If the contractor plans on selling the wood for firewood or is unable to market the wood, the orange marked oak may be moved to an area with no oak trees within a mile radius prior to April 15, 2013. If the wood is moved to a location where there is no oak present it may not be moved again until after July 15, 2013.
- E. If any oak marked with orange paint can not be processed by April 15, 2013, the wood must be hauled off site at an approved area that has no oak trees within 1 mile or on a site where the wood is covered with a dark plastic tarp. The tarp must cover the wood to the ground and the wood must remain covered from April 15, 2013 to July 15, 2013. After July 15, 2013, the wood can be disposed of at the purchaser's discretion.

# 2.1.11 - Description of timber note (2/04)

Note that when red oak is mentioned in the specifications and volume estimates pin oak and dead oak are included as well.

Units 1 and 2 contain multiple epi-centers of oak wilt.

#### 3.3 - Pre-measured Sales

#### 3.3.4 - Dividing payment units (12/08)

5.2.1.2.1 - Slash removal, right-of-way (12/04)

All slash must be removed at least 10 feet from the cleared right-of-way of forest roads and 50 feet from the edge of the Sturgeon Landing Road.

# 5.2.3.2 - Operating restrictions (9/11)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1 and 2, unless changed by written agreement, cutting, skidding and hauling of all oak must be completed by April 15, 2013. This restriction is to minimize/reduce the spread of oak wilt.

# 5.4.1 - Rutting restriction, general (1/09)

Operations are to cease immediately if equipment and weather conditions result in rutting of roads and skid trails which is 12 inches or greater in depth and 50 feet in length. The Unit Manager or his/her representative may restrict hauling and/or skidding if ruts exceed the specified depth. With the Unit Manager or his/her representative's approval, the Purchaser may return to the area when the risk of rutting has decreased.

#### 1 - Sale Area

#### 1.2 - Boundaries

#### 1.2.1 - Painted boundaries (12/08)

The sale boundary and Payment Unit boundaries are marked and identified by blue, red and yellow paint. Exterior sale boundary lines against private property are marked with blue paint. Exterior sale boundary lines against state are marked with red paint. Interior Payment Unit boundaries are marked with yellow paint. Do not cut painted boundary line trees unless also marked with orange paint. Yellow painted trees designating an interior Payment Unit boundary are only to be cut when all surrounding Payment Units have been paid for.

#### 2 - Timber Specifications

#### 2.1 - Included Timber

# 2.1.1 - Clearcut unit(s) with unmerchantable trees (8/11)

Within Payment Unit(s) 4 and 8, cut all trees that are three (3) inches or more in diameter measured at a point four and one-half (4-1/2) feet above ground level regardless of merchantability; except trees marked with green paint. In addition, within unit 4 do not cut cedar.

In addition, within unit 8 do not cut white pine and red pine.

# 2.1.3 - Cut tree marked unit(s) (12/08)

Within Payment Unit(s) 3, all white pine are designated for cutting when marked with orange paint above and below stump height, regardless of merchantability. In addition, cut all other species of trees greater than three (3) inches in diameter.

#### 2.1.4 - Species designation unit(s) (12/08)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1, all oak marked with orange paint is designated for cutting. Unit 1 contains two epi-centers of oak wilt that are being treated per the specifications listed below.

In addition, within unit 1 cut all species greater than three (3) inches in diameter; except trees marked with green paint.

All wood designated for cutting in unit 1 must be cut by April 1, 2013 and all wood must be skid and decked by April 15, 2013. Also, all oak must be hauled off site by April 15, 2013.

- A. Within unit 1; oak trees marked with orange paint must be harvested and removed prior to April 1, 2013.
- B. Oak trees marked with orange paint must be cut and removed from a payment unit prior to cutting any unmarked oak in that payment unit. Orange painted marked oak may not be mixed with the unmarked oak.
- C. The contractor must inform the Timber Sale Administrator when cutting of the marked oak trees is completed in a payment unit prior to cutting any other trees in that payment unit.
- D. Oak marked with orange paint must be chipped, taken to a wood processing facility, or sawn into dimensional lumber products at a mill by April 15, 2013. Note that the mixed softwood volume contains about 100 cords of white pine and 50 cords of balsam fir. The black spruce volume contains about 140 cords of white spruce. The aspen volume contains about 80 cords of balm.

Within Payment Unit(s) 2, 5, 6 and 7 cutting and skidding are limited to the period of December 1st to March 31st, unless there is a dry period of time and the sale administrator allows a contractor to operate during this period of time. This restriction is because of low wet ground within all of these units.

# 5.2.3.2 - Operating restrictions (9/11)


