Species Description

Rainbow trout yearlings are stocked into Caspian Pond on an annual basis. Fish typically range from 10-16 inches in length.

Noteworthy

There is a small park in development on the shore of this pond and a small handicap accessible fishing pier and picnic area. The shoreline of the pond does not have any camps or homes and remains mostly undeveloped. Although this pond is open all year for fishing, extreme caution must be taken for venturing out on ice. This body of water rarely generates adequate ice for safe ice fishing.

Fishing Regulations

Caspian Pond is a small body of water available to anglers seeking a shore fishing experience. The shore areas are very steep and it is difficult to impossible to wade along the shore edge on most of the pond. However, the small pier and open areas along the shore make it possible to fish from much of the mainland. Caspian Pond is a designated Type B trout lake. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Lake Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

Caspian Pond is located within the town of Caspian. From the Caspian city hall proceed east up Caspian Road just past a small bridge over the Iron River. At this point turn left off Caspian Road into a small park in which there is a shore fishing pier.
