### ***Species Description***

Farwell Lake is located in Jackson County, Michigan. This lake is 213 acres in size. It is 43 feet deep at its deepest point. Anglers can expect to catch a variety of fish in addition to rainbow trout, including black crappie, bluegill and largemouth bass.

Public access is from Pine Hills Lake in Jackson County as there is no direct land access to Farwell Lake. This site has 18 parking spaces available with one skid pier for launching and retrieving a boat. The boat launch and parking is located at 130 Steves Scenic Drive.
