Rainbow Trout

Species Description

Predominantly rainbow trout with size ranges dependent upon the time of year. Sub-legal fish are abundant soon after stocking in the spring. By late summer, fish stocked in that year are around 11-13 inches. Some fish survive multiple years, and trout up to 20 inches have been captured during DNR Fisheries surveys.

Noteworthy

Gravel driveway and parking area. Boat launch is made of concrete planks. There is also a rustic toilet at the access site.

Fishing Regulations

Little Paw Paw Lake is a designated Type B trout lake. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Lake Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide. No natural reproduction occurs in this lake so the rainbow trout population is sustained solely by annual stocking.

Directions to Site

Little Paw Paw Lake has a boat launch and parking (9 spaces) at the DNR access site off Paw Paw Lake Drive. The site is approximately 0.9 miles west of 4th Street.
