Rainbow trout from 8 to 16 inches in size. Other common species are bluegill, largemouth bass, black crappie and yellow perch.

Fishing Regulations

Rainbow trout are stocked by the DNR Fisheries Division, however the lake supports a two story fishery for bluegill, largemouth bass, black crappie and yellow perch. Swains Lake is a designated Type C trout lake. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.
