Fish Species

Brook Trout; Steelhead

Species Description

The Brook trout found in this stretch of the West Branch of Whitefish River usually range from 2 - 9 inches in length. The Steelhead include some adults as well as juveniles that range up to 10 inches in length on average.

Noteworthy

For the angler targeting brookies or steelhead in this stretch of the river focus your efforts on the riffle to pool transitions.

Fishing Regulations

The area of the West Branch of Whitefish River at the CR-38 bridge crossing has split regulation types. Upstream from the bridge at CR-38 is designated as a Type 1 trout stream and downstream from the bridge at CR-38 is designated as a Type 4 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From the corner of US-41 and County Road 38 travel east on CR-38 for approximately 4.5 miles to the first bridge crossing over the river. Access the river by using the county road right of way along the road and bridge. CR-38 is also sometimes referred to as Forest Service Road 2236.
