Fish Species

Brown Trout; Steelhead

Species Description

Lake Michigan spawning runs of steelhead trout and Chinook salmon. Stocked brown trout and rainbow trout.

Noteworthy

Steelhead fishing occurs from late October through June and Chinook salmon during September and October. Brown trout and rainbow trout fishing occurs all year. Fishing is best by wading from the shoreline.

Fishing Regulations

The Muskegon River in this area is designated a Type 4 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

Begin at the intersection of M-37 and M-82 (Croton Drive) on the north side of the town of Newaygo. Travel on Croton Drive east 5 miles to the intersection of Pine Street from the south, then turn right and travel 1 mile to 72nd Avenue. Then travel west (right) 0.5 miles until the road ends and take the two-track south 0.25 miles to the end of the road where there is parking for about 5 vehicles. Take the path about 0.25 miles to the river. The two-track is very rough and sometimes impassable during wet weather.
