Brook Trout; Brown Trout

Species Description

Both brook trout and brown trout are found at this location. The brown trout typically range up to 12 inches in length with some fish as large as 20 inches. The brook trout commonly range up to 9 inches in length.

From the intersection of M-28 and M-94 east of Munising, travel south for 14.2 miles on M-94 to the USFS campground. From Manistique travel north 19.8 miles on M-94 to the USFS campground.
