Species Description

A 2014 Fisheries Survey found several trout and salmon species here. Fish ranged in size from three to 36 inches in total length.

Noteworthy

This is a remote area adjacent to a campground has diverse fishing opportunities. The Crow River contains woody and rocky habitat characteristics of good trout waters. Also, the Crow River is suspected of having "Coaster" brook trout, however, survey data documenting the presence of a "Coaster" population are inconclusive.

Fishing Regulations

This river is a Type 4 trout stream. Please review the Inland Trout and Salmon Regulations found in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From Gould City travel 4.6 miles south on S. Gould City Road and turn left (east) onto Simmons Woods Road. Then travel 2 miles and then Simmons Woods Road will curve right (south) and then after 1/2 mile it will curve left (east). Continue east on Simmons Woods Road and you will pass Duel Lake camp area, then the road will come to a "Y". Turn left (north) onto the two-track. Travel approximately 1.35 miles until you come to a red pine stand of trees where the road will come to another "Y". Take a right (east, southeast) onto the two-track. Travel approximately 1.3 miles until you arrive at a small, sandy clearing adjacent to the Crow River.
