Brook Trout; Brown Trout

Species Description

Wild brook and brown trout are both present here. Brook trout up to eight inches are present but not common. Brown trout can grow to 18 inches or larger in this reach by they are not abundant. Both species likely use this reach of river more during the spring months when the temperatures are much cooler.
