Alberta Pond, also known as Lake Plumbago, is a 16-acre pond that is stocked every spring with 1,000 7-8 inch brook trout and almost every fall with 200 18-20 inch adult brook trout.

This scenic pond is located on Highway US-41 and receives heavy fishing pressure year round. This pond has easy parking, a picnic table, and open-space shorefishing from grass banks. It's also perfect for kayak use. Most anglers use artificial bait, minnow or nightcrawlers. Bait can be purchased at Indian Country Sporting Goods in the town of L'Anse. Most of the fish caught here are of legal size. This is an easy place to learn how to fish!
