Wild brook trout to 12 inches and wild brown trout to 20 inches can be found here.

Noteworthy

Anglers of the Au Sable has done a considerable amount of habitat work in this reach, funded in part by the DNR Fisheries Division Habitat Improvement Account. Habitat work includes placement of whole trees and log structures. This site is a small state-owned parcel that gets its name from a silhouette sculpture of a fisherman made out of copper. This "copper Fisherman" is typically on the river bank of the private property parcel next to the public access site.

Fishing Regulations

The North Branch of the Au Sable River near Copper Fisherman is a designated Gear Restricted stream. Please refer to the Michigan Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From County Road 612, go north on Twin Bridges Road for .35 miles. Take a right onto a dirt road and continue approximately 100 yards to a small parking area. From the parking area, there is a trail to the east that takes you down a short hill for about 150 yards to the river.
