The river is easy to wade and offers open tree canopy that is favorable for fly fishing enthusiasts. There are no bait or tackle shops in Wakefield, Bessemer or Ironwood - other than purchasing worms and crawlers from any Holiday gas station location.

Directions to Site

From the town of Bessemer, proceed north at the intersection of Highway US-2 and North Moore Street. In .7 miles, North Moore Street turns left and becomes Black River Road. Continue north on Black River Road for 2 miles until you come to Hedburg Road. Turn right on Hedburg Road and you will be at the Black River.
