Brook Trout; Brown Trout; Steelhead

Species Description

Although you may get an occasional brown or brook trout, most trout caught here will be steelhead. Some steelhead are stocked in the Carp River each year, but there is also natural reproduction (wild fish). In the fall, you might catch some Chinook, coho or pink salmon.

Noteworthy

This access site is used primarily for steelhead. There is a concrete fishing pier along the river that was built during the hey-day of smelt dipping. Steelhead fishing here is primarily done in the spring and fall.

From Mackinac Trail, go northeast on Carp River Road. Then take USFS 3127 to the east (Carp River Boat Spur).
