Directions to Site

Turn North off US-2 onto Forest Highway 13. Proceed 28.2 miles and turn Left on Forest Road 2254. Proceed 0.9 miles to junction and turn Left on Forest Road 2268. Proceed 1.4 miles and turn Left onto two-track. Stay Left and go 1.5 miles to two-track. Left on two-track 0.3 miles to Bette's Pond.
