<u>Comments from stakeholders received prior to Compartment Review</u> No comments.

Compartment 50 (Fanelli)

No changes.

Compartment 56 (Brinks)

Stand 51-Add comment to other comments. Verify with wildlife staff to make sure no impact to EO.

Stand 57-Drop the southeastern section. Add site condition.

Stand 71-Drop the area northeast of the road. Allow for harvesting of road trees.

Compartment 63 (Fanelli)

No changes.

Compartment 16 (Fanelli)

No changes.

Compartment 20 (Radecki)

Stand 15- 5C site condition. MNFI review and final version of pine guidance. Update treatment to favor the red pine.

Stand 74- 5C site condition. MNFI review. Leave all pine, hemlock, and cedar. Within 1400 feet of the shoreline leave 50-60 BA including leave species. Leave larger retention areas that (0.25-.5) include fir rejen. Exclude hemlock area. Leave some scattered oak. Adjust the road and trail buffer. Leave brush piles along the conifer edge. Consult with PRD on road improvement.

Compartment 25 (Fanelli)

Stand 40-Single tree to a seed tree split stand only 25 acres. Leave cedar and hemlock along with a tree every 70 feet.

Stand 60- Shelterwood no cutting 25 feet of Beaver Tail Creek. 70-80 BA within 100 feet outside of this leave 40BA of oak, cedar, and hemlock and some maple.

Compartment 193 (J. Burnham)

No changes.

Compartment 123 (Plato)

Stand 25- Trim off the south end. Keep the original treatment. Remove the area of the crossing.

Stand 21- Leave all hemlock except for operability.

Stand 39-Merge treatments. Exclude areas of dense cedar and allow for operational cedar outside of those areas. Run red line with Wildlife Division.

Compartment 132 (Plato)

Stand 9-Add scarification and burn next steps. OOYE- Stand 42076070- Add single tree selection same as stand 32.

Compartment 135 (Plato)

Stand 68-Add comment to leave some scattered cedar. Add rest of the stand north of the power line remove 5C site condition. Do not cut hemlock. Adjust buffer on stream. Leave a retention along stand 67.

Compartment 145 (Brinks)

Add treatment to the rest of the Gem Road.

Compartment 148 (Plato)
