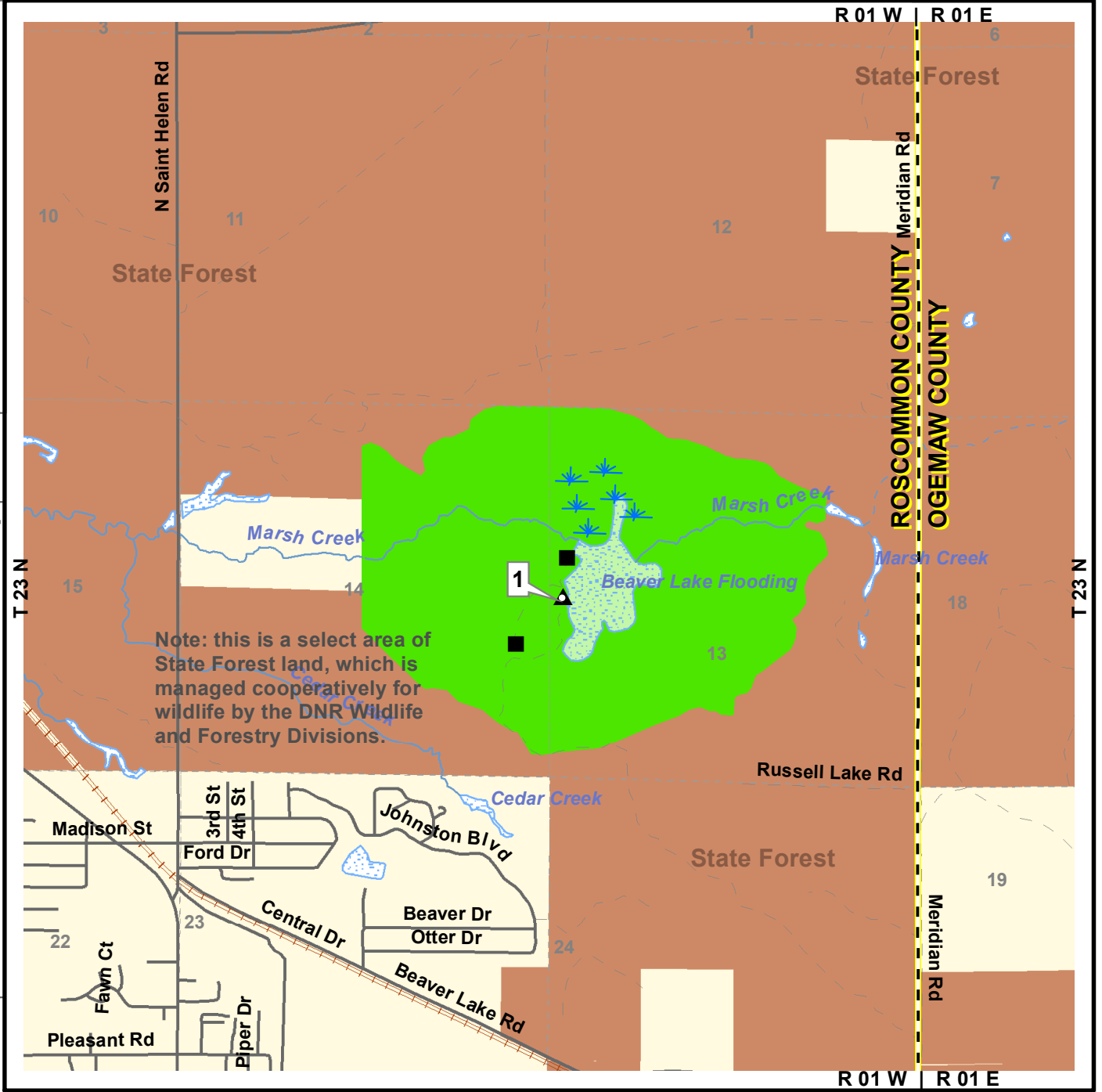

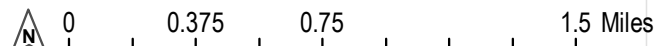


Note: this is a select area of State Forest land, which is managed cooperatively for wildlife by the DNR Wildlife and Forestry Divisions.
