



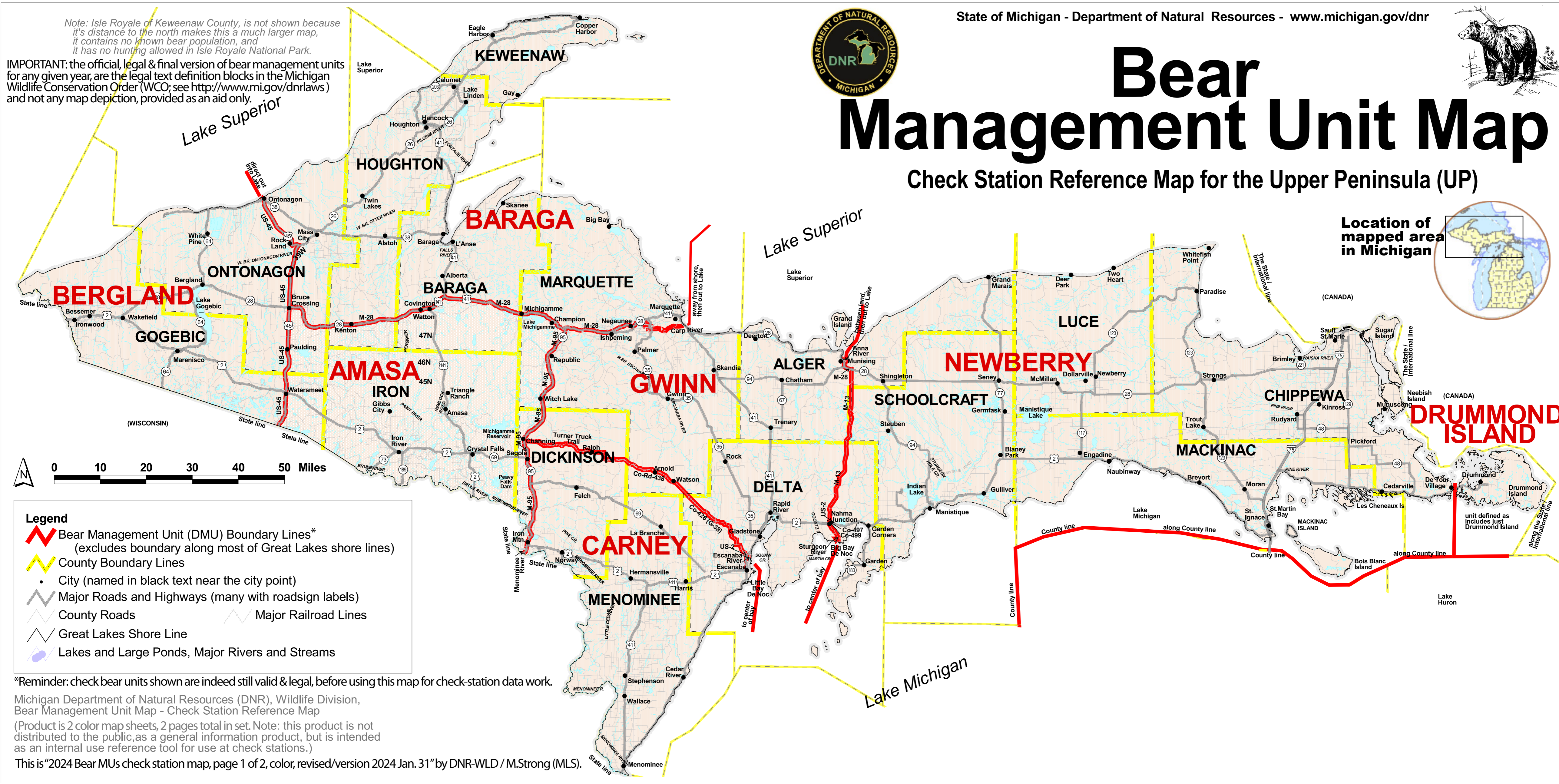
Bear Management Unit Map

Check Station Reference Map for the Upper Peninsula (UP)

Note: Isle Royale of Keweenaw County, is not shown because it's distance to the north makes this a much larger map, it contains no known bear population, and it has no hunting allowed in Isle Royale National Park.

IMPORTANT: the official, legal & final version of bear management units for any given year, are the legal text definition blocks in the Michigan Wildlife Conservation Order (WCO; see <http://www.mi.gov/dnrlaws>) and not any map depiction, provided as an aid only.
