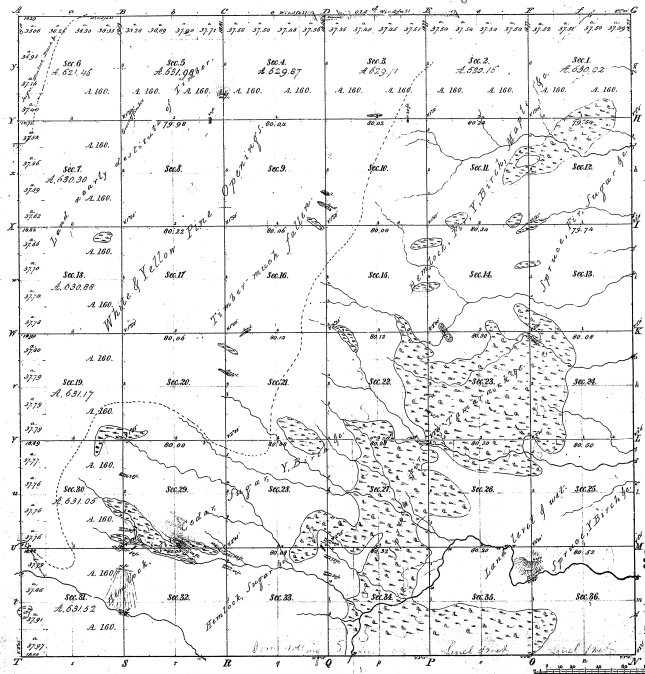

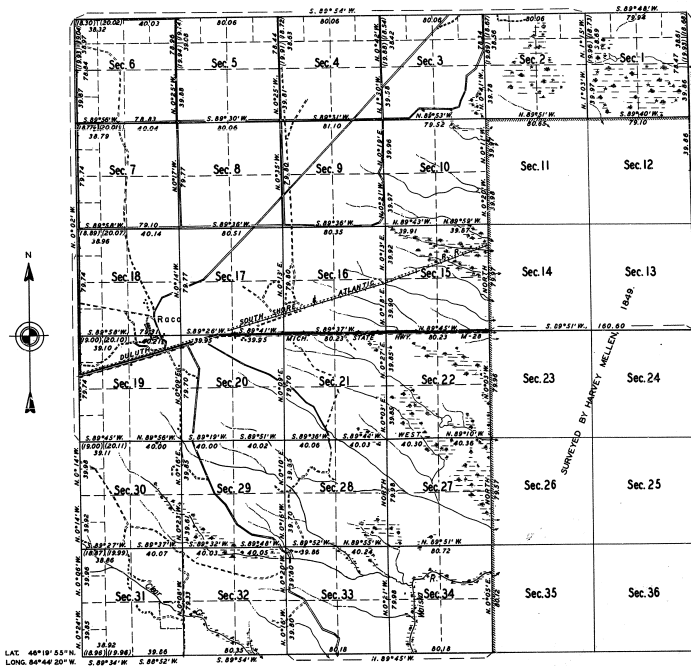

MEMORANDUM
THIS PLAT OF THE RESURVEY OF T. 46 N., R. 3 W., DELINEATES A RETRACEMENT AND REESTABLISHMENT OF THE LINES OF THE ORIGINAL SURVEY, AS SHOWN UPON THE PLAT APPROVED MARCH 14, 1890, IN THEIR TRUE ORIGINAL POSITIONS ACCORDING TO THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE OF THE POSITION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNERS. ALL DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE MEASUREMENTS SHOWN ON THE ORIGINAL PLAT AND THOSE DERIVED IN THE RETRACEMENT HAVE BEEN DISTRIBUTED PROPORTIONALLY BETWEEN THE ACCEPTED CORNERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SURVEYING RULES. REFERENCE WILL BE MADE TO THE ORIGINAL PLAT FOR THE SHOWING OF AREAS AND MORE DETAILED DESCRIPTIONS OF THE VARIOUS SMALLER SUBDIVISIONS.

THE RESURVEY WAS EXECUTED PURSUANT TO AUTHORITY CONTAINED IN GENERAL LAND OFFICE LETTER 128803 "K" DATED MARCH 22, 1941.

THE TOWNSHIP SUPPORTS A SCATTERED SECOND GROWTH OF BUCKLE, BIRCH, PINE, MAPLE, SPRUCE, AND CEDAR TIMBER, WITH DENSE UNDERGROWTH OF YOUNG TINDER OF THE SAME SPECIES. IN THE NORTHWESTERN PORTION OF THE TOWNSHIP LARGE AREAS HAVE BEEN RE-PLANTED IN JACK, NORWAT, AND WHITE PINE.
