

(E) 25-25 TOWNSHIP NO.43 NORTH, RANGE NO.18 WEST, OF THE MICHIGAN MERIDIAN, MICHIGAN. DEPENDENT RESURVEY. ISLAND SURVEY, SECTION 33. THIS PLAT OF THE RESURVEY OF T. 43 N., R. 18 W., DELIN-EATES A RETRACEMENT AND REESTABLISHMENT OF THE LINES OF THE ORIGINAL SURVEY AS SHOWN UPON THE PLAT APPROVED DECEMBER 19, 1830, IN THEIR TRUE ORIGINAL POSITIONS ACCORDING TO THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE OF THE POSITION OF THE ORIG-INAL CORNERS. ALL DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE MEASUREWENTS SHOWN ON THE ORIGINAL PLAT AND THOSE DERIVED IN THE RETRACE-WENT HAVE BEEN DISTRIBUTED PROPORTIONALLY BETWEEN ACCEPTED FERSI MAPE SEEM DISSISSIONED PROPORTIONALLY SEIMEEM ACCEPTED CORNERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SURVEYING RULES. REFERENCE WILL BE MADE TO THE ORIGINAL PLAT FOR THE SHOWING OF AREAS AND MORE DETAILED DESCRIPTIONS OF THE VARIOUS SMALLER SUBDIVI-THE PLAT ALSO REPRESENTS THE SURVEY OF AH ISLAND IN LAKE EVA IN SECTION 33, WHICH WAS NOT INCLUDED IN THE ORIGINAL SURVEY OF THE TOWNSHIP. THE RESURVEY WAS EXECUTED PURSUANT TO AUTHORITY CONTAINED IN GENERAL LAND OFFICE LETTER 1676465 "E", DATED MARCH 23, N.89* 31'W. THE TOWNSHIP EMBRACES MOSTLY CUT-OVER LAND FROM WHICH THE THE TORNSHIP EURAGES WOSTLY CUT-OVER LAW FROM WHICH THE ORIGINAL THEER GROWTH WAS BEEN REMOVED. THE PRESENT GROWTH CONSISTS LARGELY OF DENSE JACK PINE AND MAPLE BRUSH; EXTENSIVE AREAS IN THE CENTRAL PORTION OF THE TOWNSHIP MAYE BEEN REPLANTED WITH SEVERAL SPECIES OF PINE. 80.88 S.89*42'W. ac.5 Sec.4 AREA RESURVEYED, 22,503.32 ACRES.
