

MEMORANDUM.

THIS PLAT REPRESENTS THE SUMPLY OF THREE ISLANDS IN A MEANDRED LANE IN SECTION 16, WHICH WERE NOT SHOWN UPON THE TOWNSHIP PLAT APPROVED SEPTEMBER 1, 1853. THE SUMPLY WAS EXECUTED PURSUANT TO AUTHORITY CONTINUED IN CEMERAL LAND OFFICE LETTER 118255 FC., DATED JULY 1, 1929, WHICH BEARS DEPARTMENTAL APPROVAL UNDER DATE OF JULY 5, 1929.
