FORDYTH, ASSIGNEE OF JACQUES LABELLE AND FRANCOIS LABELLE, IS NOTED IN BOOK NO. 2 OF THE REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONERS ON LAND CLAIMS IN MICHIGAN (AMERICAN STATE PAPERS, GALE AND BEATON EDITION, VOLUME 5, PAGE 110). THE CLAIM WAS SURVEYED BY JOSEPH FLETCHER IN 1822 AS CLAIM NO. 474, ADDITIONAL DONATIONS ON THE DETROIT RIVER.
