### A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

M1: PLS-William A. Burt, DS, 1841, Set Post Corner between town's 46 and 47 north- Tamarack 6", S.60 E., 146 links, Spruce 5", N.53 W., 102 links. Alger County Road Commission, Walter W. Gleason, County Surveyor, 1913, Set standard iron corner from original government field notes. No references given. Corner position shown on MDSH Project plans No. 02022 and 2-28 for highway M-94. Monument material and witnesses not given. CCI Forestry Division, Land and Timber Examination Report, R. Radcliffe, RLS, 1944, Notes on timber cruise map an iron corner at corner position. No references given.

## B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

M1: Found 2 inch galvinized iron pipe with brass cap marked "33 feet S. to Cor.", north of paved highway and a 6 inch cedar post with Michigan Department of Conservation tag to identify corner marked "Cor. 33 feet S." Also found 2 inch galvinized iron pipe with 3 1/4 inch brass cap marked " 33 feet N. to Cor. ", south of paved highway. A search was made with a locator and results indicated a iron monument deep under highway. Established corner position on line between monuments and 33 feet south of north monument. Corner position is at location indicated by iron locator. Measurement to corner west along highway compares to highway records very well. A search was made at GLO bearing tree positions, evidence is lost. Corner position is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

#### C. Description of monument for comer and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

M1: Set 5/8" x 18" rebar w/ Berntsen Cap no. RBD5325 stamped to identify corner position. Established the following reference trees w/ BT signs, blazed, scribed and painted. Tamarack 6', N.59 W., 85.68 feet, 'S36 BT', Cedar 5', N.40 E., 64.49 feet, 'S31 BT', Tamarack 8', S.43 E., 76.66 feet, 'S6 BT', P.Pole, S.63 W., 56.45 feet, \* scribed BT @ ground level \*. All bearings are magnetic.
