A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

D1: PLS - William A. Burt, DS, 1841, Set quarter Section post * Sugar 8, N.77 E., 12 links * Birch 8, N.49 W., 20 links **** Edwin Swan, RLS, 1937, Alger County Road Commission alignment of County Road H-58 from Van Meer to Melstrand. * No corner position shown on plans. **** Robert L. Jamros, 1980. * Found 2" G.I.P. (brass cap missing) 3 1/2' below surface of asphalt road H-58. * Found 2" G.I.P. with brass cap on North side of road, marked 33 feet South to 1/4S., and 2" G.I.P. with brass cap on South side of road, marked, 33 feet North to 1/4S. * Set 1/2" x 18" rebar with cap at surface of road. * Witness, 12" Maple, N.27 W., 55.25 feet * 6" Maple, S.50 W., 59.90 feet. * Recorded in L.3, P.351, Alger County Records.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

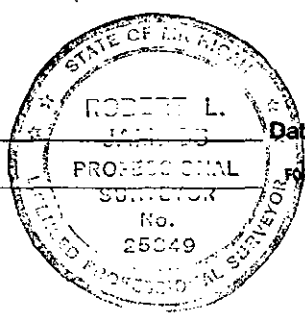
D1: Found 1/2" rebar w/ I.D. cap (damaged) in asphalt pavement 6 feet South of centerline. Evidence of fence row South from corner position. Found 33 feet North of corner position a 2" Galvanized Iron Pipe w/ 3 1/4" Brass cap stamped "33' S. to 1/4S". Also found 33 feet South of corner position a 2" Galvanized Iron Pipe w/ 3 1/4" Brass cap stamped "33' N. to 1/4S". Author unknown. Existing reference trees of 1980 report found in good condition. * Replaced existing monument with new monument and established additional references objects. * Monument at existing corner position as found is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

D1: Replaced existing 1/2" rebar with a 5/8" X 18" Rebar w/ Berntsen 3 1/4" cap no. RBD5325, stamped to identify corner position. Renewed two existing reference trees with BT signs and paint. Added two additional reference trees, BT signs, Blazed, Scribed and Painted. Set PK nails w/ aluminum I.D. washers for measure. * Exist. BT, Maple 8", S.49 W., 59.95 feet to an exist. nail, Face blazed. * Exist. BT, Maple 15", N.22 W., 55.29 feet to an exist. nail, Face blazed. * Maple 12", N.36 E., 68.93 feet, '1/4S BT'. * Maple 8", S.55 E., 70.69 feet, '1/4S'. * All bearings are magnetic.
