DeLamater, RLS, 1954, This corner was found by forestry division survey crew, while making a partial resurvey of this township. One original BT still in place and in fair condition. Set 1° pipe with 4° brass cap and established the following reference trees, W.Pine 14", N.25 E., 44 links, W.Pine 14", S.30 W., 45 links. Filing No. 66, Alger County Records. No other subsequent restoration.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

E10: Found one inch galvinized iron pipe with four inch brass cap and two existing bearing trees as stated in the 1954 report, blazes grown over. Existing monument was set as stated in 1954 report, from one original bearing tree still in place, in fair condition,remains of original BT not apparent. Existing BT's upgraded to current Alger County standards and established additional references. Corner position has been verified against corners North and South. Monument as set is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

E10: Stamped P.A. 345 in existing four inch brass capped Department of Conservation Monument. Renewed existing reference trees w/ BT signs and paint. Established additional reference trees w/ BT signs, blazed, scribed and painted. Set PK nails for measure w/ Alum. I.D. washers in the following reference trees. Ex. W.Pine 24", S.86 W., 30.13 feet, "Dbl. Blzd.", Ex. W.Pine 28", N.29 E., 29.84 feet, "Dbl. Blzd.", Hemlock 5", N.50 W., 34.23 feet, "1/45 BT", Balsam 7", S.24 E., 16.78 feet, "1/45 BT", Survey marker sign on six foot steel post, S.49 W., 1.45 feet. All bearings are magnetic.
