F7: Located corner search area by calculated position and standard field survey methods. Found 1° iron pipe with 4° brass cap. The references of the 1960 report, 17° R.Pine and 22° W.Pine stump have been removed and/or destroyed. Corner position as found lies 5.6 feet south of line and 5.3 feet west of midpoint between corners 1/2 mile east and 1/2 mile west. Established new reference trees to corner monument. Existing corner monument as found is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
