A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

K3: PLS - George E. Adair, DS, 1851, Set post corner of Sections 1-2-11 & 12 * Sugar 16, S.63 E., 17 links * Maple 14, N.44 1/2 W., 28 links ***** Ray J. Brotherton, RLS, 1949. * Set iron and W.Pine post by extending South line of Section 1 a distance of 40.01 chains from the South 1/4 corner west through line tree (Sugar 11') found at 49.31 chains and Fir line tree found at 72.13 chains per original field notes. * Witness, 10' Beech, N.30 W., 15.0 feet and 4' Maple, S.49 E., 26.0 feet. * C.C.I.Co. Records. ***** Robert E. Schmeling, RLS, 1980. * Found restoration work of Mr. Brotherton. Also found top of 5' W.Pine post on ground and point thereof in place. * Paint lines running North, South, East and West. * Set 1 1/2" diam. 4 foot long galvanized iron pipe with brass cap stamped to identify corner position. * Hemlock 10", S.65 E., 53.8 feet, scribed. * Hard Maple 15", S.43 E., 51.8 feet, scribed. * Red Maple 11", S.89 W., 58.8 feet, scribed. * Hard Maple 9", N.35 W., 32.1 feet, scribed. * Recorded in L.1, P.347, Alger County Records. ***** No other subsequent restoration.

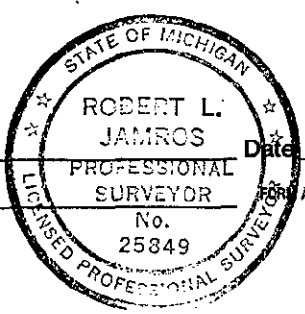
B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

K3: Located existing 1 1/2" diam. galvanized iron pipe with brass cap (badly damaged) with a portion of iron leaf spring at base of existing monument. Also located two existing BT's of the 1980 report. * Of the unrecorded report of 1949 found 10' Beech, N.30 W., 15.0 feet dead, but standing, and the Maple BT in the SE position destroyed. * Replaced existing damaged monument with new monument. * Monument position as found is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

K3: Set Berntsen Monument No. A1NB30 stamped to identify corner position. * Renewed existing reference trees w/ BT signs and paint. * Established additional reference trees w/ BT signs, blazed, scribed and painted. * Set PK nails for measure w/ Alum. I.D. washers in the following reference trees. * Exist. BT, Maple 24", S.90 W., 57.93 feet, marks still visible. * Exist. BT, Maple 20", S.63 E., 54.25 feet, marks still visible. * Maple 8", N.18 E., 26.80 feet, "S1 BT". * Maple 8", S.08W., 47.61 feet, "S11 BT". * Survey marker sign on six foot steel post, S.69 E., 1.0 feet. * All bearings are magnetic.
