No references given. No other subsequent restoration.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

89: Found Alger County Standard Monument with brass cap dated March 1916. Also found a splintered large Maple stub eight feet high at GLO BT location, N.31 E., 39 links. Area on tree that contained the blazing and scribing is splintered and decayed. Old blaze lines E, W, and S. from the monument position. Existing brass capped monument neasures well with large Maple stub at BT location and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

B9: Stamped P.A. 345 in brass cap of cast steel monument. Established reference trees w/ BT signs, blazed, scribed and painted. Set PK nails for measure w/ Alum. I.D. washers in the following reference trees. Maple 20°, 5.66 E., 27.65 feet, 1/4s BT , Maple 8°, N.24 E., 30.18 feet, 1/4s BT , Beech 10°, N.60 W., 33.15 feet, 1/4s BT , Beech 8°, S.31 W., 44.90 feet, 1/4s BT . Survey marker sign on six foot steel post, N.60 E., 0.9 feet. All bearings are magnetic.
